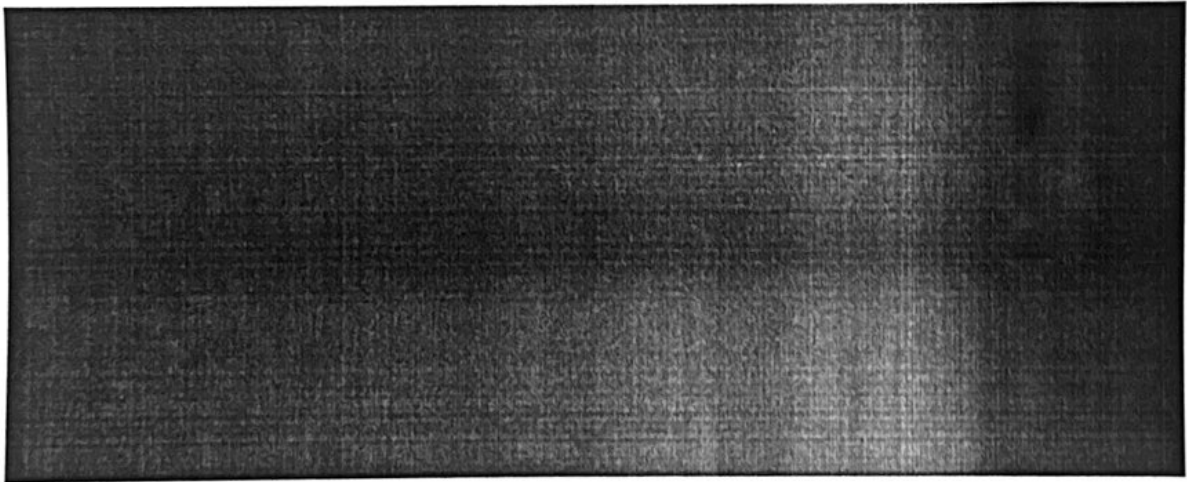

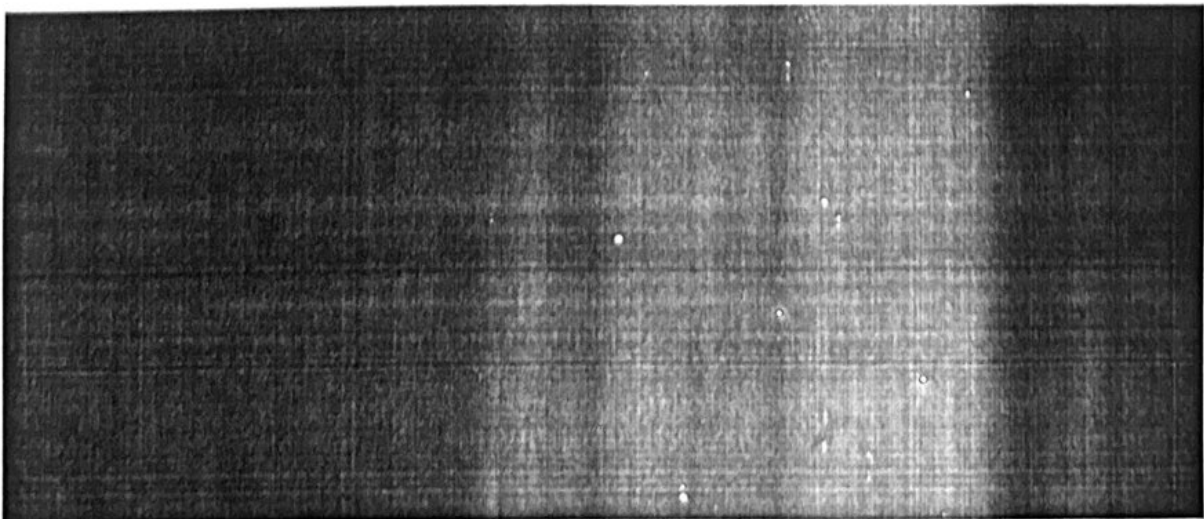

the trooper. Upon reaching the trooper I observed the male to be profusely sweating and actively resisting while on his stomach. I gave the male verbal commands to stop resisting or he would be bit by my police K9. Said male disregarded my verbal commands. At this point the trooper was attempting to gain control of the males left arm, so I attempted to gain control of his right arm to place him into wrist restraints. Said male was extremely strong, large and due to the amount, he was sweating and my training and experience as a police officer, I believed him to be under the influence of some sort of narcotic. I then administered approximately 3 strikes with a closed right fist to the suspects' right face area to gain compliance which had zero effect. The suspect was able to keep pulling his arm away from me and was twisting his body attempting to get up and away from officers. At this point Officer Palermo arrived on scene and began to assist. At one point I observed PO Palermo get "bucked off" the suspect as the suspect was still attempting to get up so PO Palermo administered OC Spray which also had zero effect. At this time more City of Newburgh Officers arrived on scene to assist with getting the large male in custody. Ultimately officers were able to secure the male into wrist restraints at which point I advised police dispatch I needed EMS on scene immediately. Moments later I then observed EMS arriving on scene. I immediately went to meet with EMS personnel and briefed them on the situation. I advised them to expedite due to the male being pepper sprayed, extremely sweating and possibly under the influence of narcotics. I then turned my attention to the motor vehicle scene, notifying Central Hudson of downed poles and wires and assisting NYSP further. See other narratives for further.
