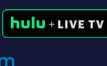

MEKADA (RUSSIAN LAYER CAKE)

INGREDIENTS

Cake:

- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 tablespoons baking powder
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 3 cups all-purpose flour

Filling:

- 8 ounces fat-free cream cheese (about 1 cup)
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- ⅓ cup granulated sugar
- 12 ounces whipped cream (about 1½ cups)

Topping:

- Fresh strawberries, sliced

INSTRUCTIONS

To make the cake:

1. **In a large mixing bowl, mix** together the heavy cream, sugar, eggs, baking powder, and salt with a rubber spatula or wooden spoon until combined (do not beat). Fold in the flour 1 cup at a time until you have a homogeneous dough. The dough will be moist and sticky.
2. **Pour** about 1 cup of batter at a time into a large nonstick



skillet, set over medium to medium-high heat, and cook into pancakes. You should have 4 pancakes total. Set aside.

To make the filling:

3. **In a stand mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, or with an electric mixer, beat** together the cream cheese, sour cream, vanilla extract, and sugar until well combined and slightly fluffy. Mix in the whipped cream by hand with a rubber spatula or wooden spoon until well combined.

To assemble the cake:

4. **On a cake stand or plate, layer** the pancakes with about ½ cup of the filling spread in between each layer and on top. Arrange fresh strawberry slices on top and serve.
