Why do horses sleep standing up?

BIG QUESTION: How do horses' legs move? - June, 3




Let's move like a horse!

Walk like horse on two feet

In a four-beat gait for a horse, each hoof hits the ground separately.

The average speed is about 4 miles per hour.

Gallop like a horse on two feet.

A four-beat gait for a horse is the fastest gait, with a distinct pause between strides.

The average speed can exceed 25 miles per hour.
