## Trusted news for western Mass.

NEPM is committed to trusted, in-depth journalism that informs and connects western Massachusetts. Our newsroom delivered daily coverage of the issues shaping life in the region, from education and housing to health care, the environment, and the economy. NEPM reporters produced enterprise stories, breaking news, and special series like Hunger Awareness Week, while providing context and analysis during major events, including the 2024 election. The Rundown with Carrie Saldo further strengthened NEPM's local journalism by bringing together a weekly live panel of reporters from across western Massachusetts to examine the stories shaping the region. More than 40 journalists from 10 participating media outlets appeared on the program.

## Election 2024

NEPM delivered deep and wide-ranging coverage of the 2024 election, including hosting the only U.S. Senate debate in western Massachusetts between Sen. Elizabeth Warren and challenger John Deaton, in partnership with GBH News. NEPM also launched a partnership with The Latino Newsletter to expand election coverage for Spanish-speaking audiences in western Mass. And, we sent photojournalist Barry Goldstein to both the Republican and Democratic national conventions for the multimedia projects Red in a Blue State and Unprecedented, offering a rare look at Massachusetts delegates and their perspectives on the national stage.

## Connecting the Commonwealth: Expanding statewide news coverage

In 2024, NEPM joined forces with GBH News and CAI to launch Connecting the Commonwealth, a groundbreaking initiative to deliver timely, in-depth reporting across Massachusetts. This partnership strengthens NEPM's ability to cover statewide issues — from education and the environment to the economy and inequality — while ensuring western Massachusetts voices are part of the conversation. Stories appear regularly across radio, TV, and digital platforms, reaching audiences from

Springfield to Provincetown. In June, NEPM began airing GBH's Boston Public Radio with Jim Braude and Margery Eagan, offering western Mass. listeners fresh perspectives on the issues shaping life across the state. These efforts build on NEPM's long-standing collaboration with member stations of the New England News Collaborative, reaffirming our commitment to trusted, local journalism that connects communities and informs civic life.

Building connection through community-driven storytelling and shared traditions.

## Conexión: a natural connection

NEPM deepened its commitment to inclusive, community-centered storytelling through a bilingual digital initiative focused on Latinos' relationship with the natural world. Conexión is a short-form social media series exploring how Latinos forge personal connections with outdoor spaces. Created in collaboration with the New England News Collaborative, Our New England, NPR Oye, and NHPR, the series profiles individuals whose passions and resilience reflect their deep connection to people and place. Conexión featured a mountain biker, a rower — whose story was picked up by NPR and reached more than 284,000 views — and a plant enthusiast.

## Spotlight on food insecurity: Hunger Awareness Week and the March for the Food Bank

In November, NEPM dedicated a week of reporting to Hunger Awareness Week, shining a spotlight on food insecurity in western Massachusetts and the innovative ways local people, businesses, and nonprofits are fighting hunger, covering topics from school lunch programs to food deserts, and highlighting solutions that make a difference for those most affected. The effort culminated with the 14th annual March for the Food Bank, where Monte Belmonte pushed an empty shopping cart from Springfield to Greenfield alongside hundreds of supporters. Together, these initiatives reflect NEPM's commitment to community-driven journalism and advocacy that feeds hope as well as hunger relief.

## Legacies: Stories of Black History in the 413

In December, NEPM premiered Legacies: Stories of Black History in the 413, a series of short-form documentaries exploring Black art, history, faith, and culture in western Massachusetts. Hosted by Black history scholar Erika Slocumb, the series highlights stories of resilience and impact, including one woman's journey to uncover her family roots, the legacy of AfriCOBRA artist and muralist Nelson Stevens, and the enduring history of Mount Calvary Baptist Church. Produced by NEPM with support from Mass Humanities, Legacies elevates voices that shaped the region and deepens understanding of our collective past and future.

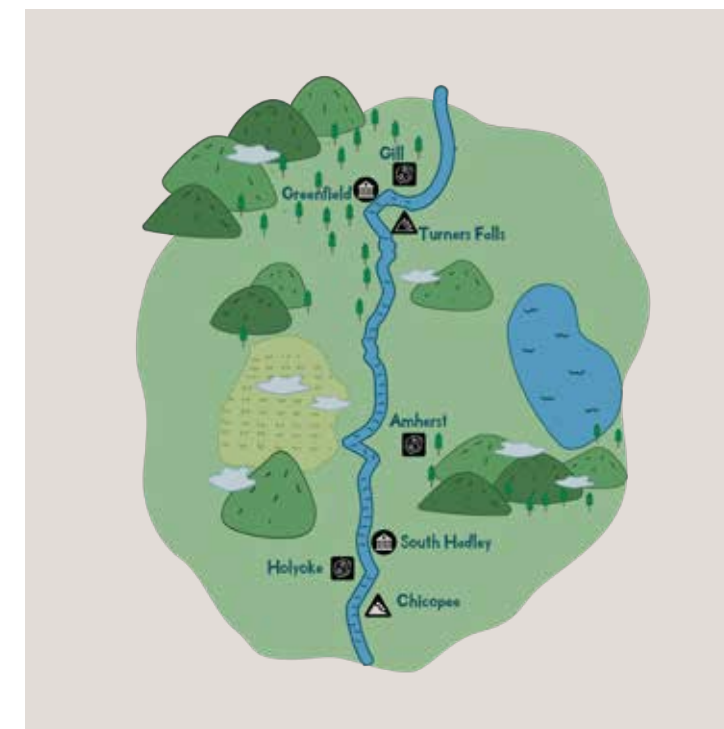

# NEPM Media Lab: Hands-on learning and workforce development for western Mass. youth

Through NEPM Media Lab, a paid internship program for high school and college students, participants build skills in multimedia production — including writing, audio and video journalism, storytelling, and publishing. Their completed projects were shared on social media as well as on NEPM and MassLive’s platforms. NEPM Education’s college interns served as mentors to high school students, supported NEPM’s instructional staff, and collaborated with NEPM News, the New England News
