## Morningside Poll 2022: Results Overview

In April 2022, the Colonel Bud Day Center for Civic Engagement released results of its fifth annual Morningside Poll. This poll measured the attitudes of Iowa residents on a variety of public policy issues and on the performance of the state's legislative and executive branches. This report outlines the key elements of the poll and its results. ${ }^{1}$

## Key Elements of the Poll

- Total respondents: 689 Iowa adults
- Sampling margin of error (MOE): $\pm 3.7$ percentage points ( $95 \%$ confidence level)
- Survey type: 150 landline, 539 cell phone computer-assisted telephone interviews (CATI)
