# The Untold Story of the Mother Road

The "Mother Road" as it was coined by John Steinbeck has struck a chord with Americans and an ever growing international audience since its inception in 1926. Its roughly 2,400 miles from Chicago to Los Angeles still represent the ultimate American experience, and almost 100 years later it still beckons the traveler. However, the narrative of the road, as conveyed by popular culture and historical works, has primarily focused on men and often overlooked the experiences of women and girls.

**Route 66 Women: The Untold Story of the Mother Road**, a threepart documentary film, uncovers the extraordinary lives and achievements of women who overcame gender discrimination and segregation to build fulfilling lives for themselves and generations to come on America's most iconic highway. From entrepreneurs to waitresses, from anthropologists to politicians, from artists to military sergeants, these women transformed their communities and the American West for the better through their hard work, perseverance and ingenuity.

**Route 66 Women** airs on 3-2 Sundays at 10:00 a.m. beginning the 6th, Mondays at 8:00 p.m. beginning the 14th and Sundays at 6:00 p.m. beginning the 20th. It will be broadcast on 3-1 Tuesdays at 8:00 p.m. beginning the 15th and Wednesdays at 8:00 a.m. beginning the 16th.

# New Season of Call the Midwife

Following an eventful Christmas special, the multi-award-winning drama **Call the Midwife** returns for season 11. It's Easter 1967, and celebrations are underway for a colorful Easter bonnet parade outside Nonnatus House.

Sister Monica Joan and Reggie are excited about the Eurovision song contest, while Cyril and Lucille settle into blissful married life. Nancy, having just passed her midwifery examinations, is about to don her red cardigan for the first time. And Derek and Audrey Fleming return to Poplar with good news.



Also in 1967, The Abortion Act was passed, legalizing abortion in a wide range of cases. This has a big impact on the women of Poplar, and on the work of the midwives at Nonnatus House.

**Call the Midwife** has already been confirmed by the BBC for season 12 (2023) and season 13 (2024). This means that the story will continue until at least the end of 1969, and potentially into the 1970s.

The Mathematical Vision of Maryam Mirzakhani

Secrets of the Surface: The Mathematical Vision of Maryam Mirzakhani examines the life and mathematical work of an Iranian immigrant to the United States who became a superstar in her field. Dr. Mirzakhani was the first woman and first Iranian to be awarded the Fields Medal, the most prestigious award in mathematics, often equated in stature with the Nobel Prize. Then just 39, Maryam had "already solved enough of pure math's Insoluble Enigmas to fill two careers." Sadly, just a few months later, Mirzakhani died from



breast cancer at the age of 40. She left behind a legacy of passion and accomplishments.

Mirzakhani's contributions are explained in the film by leading mathematicians and illustrated by animated se-

quences. Her math-

ematical colleagues from around the world, as well as former teachers, classmates, and students convey the deep impact of her achievements. The path of her education, success on Iran's Math Olympiad team, and her brilliant work make Mirzakhani an ideal role model for girls looking toward careers in science and mathematics.

# **Concert for George**

On November 29, 2002, one year after the passing of George Harrison, a performance tribute was organized in his honor. # Marie Suize Pantalon: Itinerary of a Pioneer

Marie Suize Pantalon: Itinerary of a Pioneer came from France in 1850 during the Gold Rush in California. In a cosmopolitan and essentially masculine universe, she became a successful gold miner and wine maker. She was arrested many times for wearing men's clothes. She decided to appropriate this as part of her identity and claimed the nickname: Marie Pantalon.

Marie was extremely famous and much talked about in the newspapers, but fell into oblivion. She was forgotten until 2004, when California's Amador County—known as the "The Heart of the Mother Lode"—celebrated its 150th anniversary, and decided to honor the memory of Marie Pantalon by naming her Sesquicentennial Woman of the Year. Historians and researchers describe the outstanding and entertaining life of this daughter of both France and California.

"Annie Oakley" on American Experience is the story of a five-foot, 100-pound sharpshooter who pulled herself out of poverty to become an iconic performer known the world over as a symbol of the Wild West.

Oakley was the toast of New York, London, Paris, and eventually the world. She excelled in a man's world by doing what she loved and won fame and fortune as "the little lady from Ohio who never missed a shot."

Phoebe Anne Moses, called Annie, first picked up a gun in 1875 at age 15 not to become a superstar, but to save her family from destitution. She taught herself to shoot and took to the woods of Greenville, Ohio, to hunt quail, which she would sell at the general store. Thanks to her prowess with a shotgun, Annie became the family's primary breadwinner and paid off the mortgage on the family farm.

In the midst of a crowded, patriarchal news landscape, the reporters with Khabar Lahariya-India's only newspaper run by Dalit ("low caste") womentake it upon themselves to cover their country's inequities with unflinching determination.

Armed only with their smartphones, these fearless journalists traverse the state of Uttar Pradesh, exposing government misconduct, rape culture, and rampant corruption that victimizes those without voice or power.

Led by chief reporter Meera Devi, they investigate the incompetence of the local police force, listen to and stand by victims of caste and gender violence, and challenge long-standing, harmful practices that lead to injustice and intimidation.

Independent Lens "Writing with Fire" can be seen on 3-2 Monday, the 28th at 9:00 p.m. It airs on 3-1 in early April.
