

sweeping orchestra/classic film score fans.

Jazz fans! Kristofer Maddigan's Cuphead is a three-hour score of original ragtime/'30s style swing played by utterly fab musicians and contains tributes to artists from Cab Calloway to Duke and way more. It's utterly infectious and brilliant.
