OUTREACH INITIATIVES:

Internship program for undergraduate and graduate students in the community. A variety of positions were filled, in development, marketing, production and social media. Interns receive college credit and work 10-12 hours a week during a semester or 15 weeks. A total of three interns worked during the reporting period. In addition to our internship program the station also uses the work-study program at the University of Arkansas when possible and work-study students are assigned to the station and perform a variety of tasks that give them radio experience.

A scholarship program has been established through the University of Arkansas School of Journalism. A \$1,000 to \$2,000 per year award is given to a student in the broadcast program who shows the most potential and interest in radio broadcasting.

KUAF management participates in a Job Fair held at the University of Arkansas every year. Dozens of students interested in public media are interviewed and given material describing potential careers at KUAF and public media.

We do internships, scholarships and job fairs every year for a total of six (6) initiatives every two years as required by the Federal Communications Commission.
