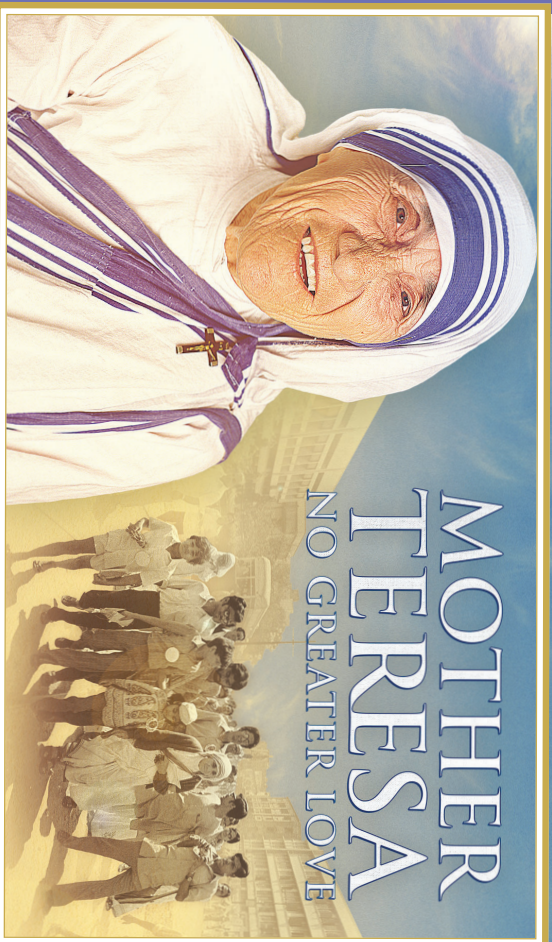

Director of Broadcasting Duane W. Ryan Retires

2023 brings with it many changes to KENW, but the most significant change by far is the retirement of our beloved Director of Broadcasting Duane Ryan, our steady hand at the helm for almost 50 years. When Mr. Ryan came to Eastern New Mexico University in 1967 as an Assistant Professor, it was his dream to bring PBS (1974) and NPR (1978) to the area to enrich the lives of citizens in eastern New Mexico and West Texas.

Throughout the decades of his leadership, Mr. Ryan created not just a Broadcast Center, but a welcoming workplace that inspired a dedicated staff. He cultivated a supportive educational environment where students could thrive. Countless Eastern New Mexico University students, who passed through the Broadcast Center over the years and have gone on to successful careers, cherish lifelong memories of Mr. Ryan's warmth and guidance as they prepared for their professional lives.

Mr. Ryan's kindness, understanding nature and vision for KENW every step along the way, from 1974 to the present, form an incredible legacy that reflects his life's work. To say it is a life well lived in the service of others does not begin to do it justice.

Jews of the Wild West

Western Jewish pioneers are a largely forgotten chapter in U.S. History. And yet, they played a definitive role shaping the expansion of the United States. By 1912, it is estimated that more than 100,000 Jews had migrated to the Wild West.

There were nationally known names such as Levi Strauss, Samsonite founder Jesse Shwayder and the Guggenheims. A young Golda Meir spent formative years in Denver.

And there were also lesser-known characters such as Solomon Bibb, a Prussian immigrant, who became a non-Native American tribal leader in New Mexico, and Solomon Carvalho, a Sephardic photographer who spent the mid-1800s documenting the territories of Kansas, Colorado and Utah. Wyatt Earp's wife, Josephine Marcus Earp, was a Jewish actress whose beauty is rumored to have triggered the fight at the OK Corral. And by the end of the 19th Century, nearly every notorious Wild West town had a Jewish mayor.
