Here's how a Repair Fair works: volunteers are given a table and workspace, community members register their broken items in advance, and we work to partner the two. Volunteers can coach a repair or complete it themselves.

This event is **FREE!** We are looking for volunteers to help repair or mend household items - such as small appliances, clothing, knick-knacks, wood repair, tool and knife sharpening, bicycle adjustments, tech help, and more!

This is a unique opportunity for community members to connect, share knowledge, and keep beloved items out of the trash.

Things to mention:

- Volunteer only, no charge for services. Tips to your repair-person are accepted.
- We will try to pair registered broken items to proper volunteers, communicate ahead of time.
- The repair person will be given a table + area to work, responsible for their own tools.
- No guarantees that items can be fixed, can not guarantee items will be returned in the same condition.

We can't fix:

- gas tools
- broken screens
- fine jewelry
- items that need to be welded
- anything too big or heavy for one person to carry
- microwaves
- dirty clothes
