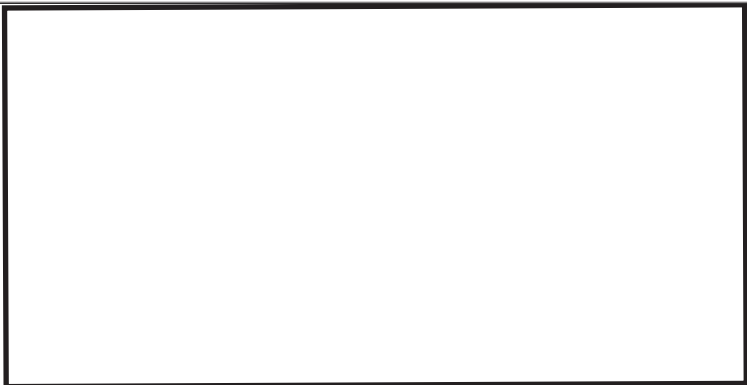

"How to Have an American Baby" on POV reveals the human dimension of the Chinese "Maternity Hotel" industry in the U.S. The film is a kaleidoscopic voyage into the shadow economy catering to Chinese tourists who travel to the U.S. to give birth in order to have babies who will be born as American citizens.

From Los Angeles to Beijing, the film introduces viewers to expectant mothers, maternity hotel operators, sales agents in China, cash-happy doctors and angry neighbors in the U.S.—as well as the invisible army of nannies, cooks, and drivers that fuel the industry.

The film also captures the fortunes and tragedies of the people caught in a global economic system that exploits and capitalizes on their desire for an American passport.

KENW-TV SCHEDULES 3-1 (HD), 3-2 (HD) AND 3-3 (SD)

KENW-TV considers Channel 3-2 to be its "main" channel and is listed below in bold. Channel 3-2 is carried by most TV cable systems in eastern New Mexico. Schedule 3-1 can be seen on the HD services of some cable companies. 3-3 is our Children's/Encore Channel (SD) and 3-4 is our FNX Channel (First Nations Experience).

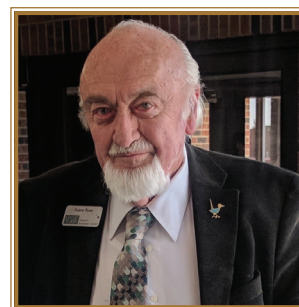

Lucy Worsley on the Mystery Queen

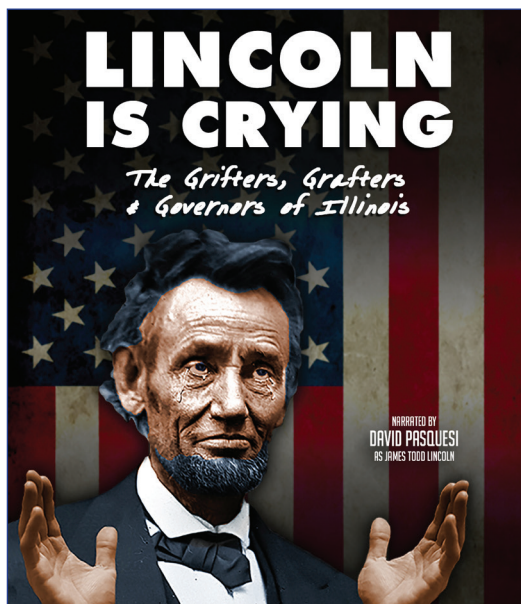

The Coming of the American Revolution

This beautifully shot film chronicles the settlement of the original thirteen colonies up to and including the American Revolution. "The Shot Heard 'round the World" refers to the opening shot of the battles of Lexington and Concord on April 19, 1775, which sparked the Revolution.

The two-hour docudrama focuses on both English and American personalities, including King George II, King George III, William Pitt, Charles Townshend, Patrick Henry, Samuel Adams, and George Mason. There are spectacular scenes of the Stamp Act Congress, the Virginia House of Burgesses, the Boston Massacre, and the Boston Tea Party. Climb the steps of the Old North Church, watch Paul Revere gallop through the darkness warning the militias, and follow the British troops to Lexington Green where Captain Parker tells his militiamen "if [the British] mean to have war, let it begin here."
