Freedom and Unity: The Vermont Movie

Thursdays at 9:00 pm; Fridays at 1:00 am; Saturdays at 2:00 pm

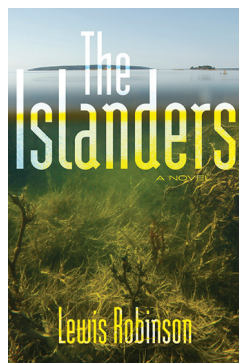
Covering over a century, from pre-Civil War to 2009, the continuing series explores labor wars, the Eugenics movement, the McCarthy era, the rise of unions, and quarry work. It looks at the people and institutions that have pushed boundaries and progressive movements, including Vermont's famous Billboard law and its groundbreaking civil union law and gay marriage. Finally, it tackles contemporary tensions over energy, the environment, and the state's future. Chronicling the struggle to close the Vermont Yankee nuclear plant, the series reveals the power of protest, the influence of lobbyists, the importance of town meeting debate, and a citizen legislature. It follows the battle over environmental impacts – and explores thorny questions about economics, sovereignty, climate change, and the power of people and community.

Our 2026 Maine Public Book Club Season Is Wrapping Up!

Where has the time gone? We are fast approaching our last two book club conversations of 2026. Unbelievable! And we are ending our season just where we started with some very interesting novels and authors. First up is *The Islanders* by Lewis Robinson. Lewis is the author of *Officer Friendly* and *Other Stories* and *Water Dogs*, and he is the winner of a Whiting Award, the PEN Oakland/Josephine Miles Award, and a Fellowship from the National Endowment for the Arts. His writing has appeared in *Sports Illustrated*, *The New York Times Book Review*, and on the NPR program *Selected Shorts*. Traces the History of Life Itself

Five-part series premieres October 14 at 9:00 pm

PONDER THIS: All the incredible diversity of animal life on Earth sprang from a single organism. Every animal, no matter how weird, is related to every other. And behind each species is an incredible story of the millions of generations that gave rise to them. **Evolution**, a new presentation from NOVA, is an epic tale that reveals the twists and turns of our existence over billions of years. This landmark series – featuring passionate scientists, gorgeous photography, and stunning animations of long-lost ancestors – explores how every animal we know and love today sprang from creatures that looked nothing like them.

“Evolution can feel like an abstract concept, but the stories at the heart of this series make it viscerally real,” said NOVA Co-Executive Producer Chris Schmidt. “Whether it’s tracing how the first light-sensing cells eventually led to a dolphin’s brain wired for complex thought, or how ancient jaw bones became the bones in our ears – these are discoveries that fundamentally change how you see your own body and every living thing around you.”

Full of surprising twists and turns over billions of years, each chapter in this enlightening tale reveals how animal life became so diverse and resilient through the awesome power of evolution. Drawing on genetic analysis and fossil records from vastly different eras and environments, **Evolution** shows audiences how the smallest mutations – repeated and inherited across countless generations – can ultimately reshape life itself. ■

The investigation has moved into the 1990s with DCI Brian Boyce’s (Hugh Bonneville) team now aware that their search is going to be wider than they thought. As pressure builds on the criminals, police track key suspects across the globe. Meanwhile, the investigation has continued for so long that Boyce’s team is losing support from its superiors. Will this case ever be solved? ■
