

The American Buffalo

Monday-Tuesday, October 16-17, 8:00 pm

The biography of an improbable, shaggy beast that has found itself at the center of many of the country's most mythic and heartbreaking tales is found in a new series by Ken Burns. **The American Buffalo** takes viewers on a journey through more than 10,000 years of North American history tracing the mammal's evolution, its significance to the Great Plains, near demise, and, most importantly, its relationship to the Indigenous People of North America. The stories of Native people anchor the series, which includes interviews with leading Native American scholars, land experts and Tribal Nation members.

The series documents the startling swiftness of the species' near extinction in the late 19th century. Numbering an estimated 30 million in the early 1800s, by 1900, the American buffalo teetered on the brink of disappearing forever, and the Native people of the Plains entered one of the most traumatic moments of their existence. But the other, lesser-known part of this story, told in the film's second episode, is about the people who set out to save the species from extermination and how they did it. 

The humans he has created are, thankfully, not flattened into props and gimmicks, which sometimes happens when writers work across time and difference; instead they pulse with aliveness, dreamlike but tangible, so real it could make you weep."



It's a Night of *Season Premieres* on Sunday, October 15!

Hotel Portofino – $8:00 \ pm$ | THIS GLAMOROUS PERIOD DRAMA is set in the beautiful Italian seaside town of Portofino. Season 2 begins in the summer of 1927 as Bella Ainsworth is still devoting all her energy into making Hotel Portofino a success. Having overcome earlier blackmailing threats from a local politician, the hotel is finally starting to prosper. Aside from her hotel duties, Bella is also concerned for her children – Lucian, whose marriage to Rose might be facing trouble, and Alice, who needs a break from her life at the hotel. With her husband Cecil's unannounced

return to Portofino, the messy private lives of her children, and an imminent visit from a travel guide that could make or break the hotel's future, Bella has her work cut out to keep all the plates spinning.

World on Fire on Masterpiece – 9:00 pm | THE EPIC WWII DRAMA continues the emotionally gripping story that follows the intertwining fates of ordinary people in five countries as they grapple with the effects of the war on their everyday lives. In Season 2, RAF pilots are sent to destroy German bombers prowling the skies above Manchester while rescue operations are underway on the streets below. The story moves from Britain into occupied France, Nazi Germany, and to the sands of the North African desert. Returning cast members include Jonah Hauer-King as Harry, an idealistic British army officer; Zofia Wichlacz as Polish resistance fighter Kasia; Lesley Manville as Robina, a British fascist sympathizer who is sheltering a young refugee; and Helen Hunt as Nancy, an American broadcaster reporting from Warsaw and Berlin.





Annika on Masterpiece – 10:00 pm | NICOLA WALKER IS BACK as DI Annika Strandhed, the speedboat-driving head of Glasgow's Marine Homicide Unit. A police procedural with wit, Season 2 finds Annika and the team solving more murders that wash up from Scotland's waters. Juggling enigmatic cases while trying to raise her rebellious teenage daughter, Morgan, the detective drops literary references linking the crime at hand to plots in classic books. And, unlike other TV detectives who discuss the case exclusively with their team, Annika addresses viewers directly, "breaking the fourth wall" that separates the action from the audience. Also appearing are Jamie Sives as DS Michael McAndrews, and Paul McGann as Morgan's therapist Jake Strathearn, who develops into something of a soul mate for single mom Annika. ■
