Aspen Public Radio | Our Story

Founded in 1980 as Roaring Fork Public Radio Translator, Aspen Public Radio has grown from broadcasting the daily hog prices from the University of Wyoming to being considered one of the most relied-upon broadcast news institutions serving Pitkin, Eagle, and Garfield counties.

Each weekday, Aspen Public Radio broadcasts 16 hours of national radio programming from NPR, American Public Media, PRX, and WNYC, along with 8 hours of international programming from the BBC and PRX (The World). **From 7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m., local newscasts and radio features are broadcast within national programming.** On the weekend, the station broadcasts a schedule of 22 national radio programs along with an evening special each Sunday night at 7 p.m., which often features a locally-recorded community conversation captured in front of a live local audience.

In addition to providing an award-winning, daily local news service, Aspen Public Radio is an NPR member station, making us a partner in producing quality journalism for our nation as a whole. **Over the past year, Aspen Public Radio journalists have had their work featured nationally on the NPR network over a dozen times, showcasing local stories which cover a wide range of topics** from Special Olympics competitions at the X Games, to Uinta Basin railway protests in Glenwood Canyon, to the wearing of a stole as freedom of speech by a student at Grand Valley High School in Parachute.

With a rapidly increasing population of more than 100,000 people, according to 2020 U.S. Census data, **the need is greater than ever to serve the diverse communities of the Roaring Fork Valley by reporting on the complex issues we are collectively working to explore and address**—with radio providing a unique and convenient way of delivering daily news and information.

Today our broadcast signal is reliably available on a single signal (88.9 FM) from **Aspen to Glenwood Springs, Rifle to Eagle**. And since you can take our service with you wherever you might want to go, Aspen Public Radio truly fits the region's rural mountain lifestyle.

Our public radio style of broadcast journalism allows local reporters to go deeper on targeted issues, such as education, the impact of human-caused climate change, and issues of public policy, by personally engaging with community members and stakeholders, sharing their voices, and identifying critical solutions to pressing issues.

And we continue to make investments in regional and national collaborations which allow for a larger distribution of our locally-produced reporting, creating a unique opportunity to advance discussion on critical issues in Aspen and the valley and beyond—throughout the state of Colorado, the mountain west region, the nation, and around the world.

Looking Ahead

As we look to 2024, Aspen Public Radio is committed to providing the news and information our audience wants and needs, addressing issues of importance to our community, and investing in emergency preparedness and capital improvements to keep our listeners safe and connected to Aspen and the valley, the nation, and the world.

Our Local Newsroom

We employ a team of five local journalists who cover education, arts & culture, government affairs, climate and the environment, health & wellness, and more, with live local newscasts broadcast weekdays from 7-9 a.m. and 4-6 p.m., and daily digital news at aspenpublicradio.org.

Elections 2024

This will be a big election year, where our local news team aims to focus on impact and context –showing how candidates and ballot measures will affect our community from Aspen to Parachute. Stories will be accessible and engaging, so voters can make informed decisions.

Spanish News and Information

We are committed to providing the highest-quality local news and information in Spanish, collaborating with *Sol del Valle* to publish our translated features in service to the approximately 33,000 Spanish-speaking residents in our coverage area.

Smuggler Mountain Tower

In late 2022, it was determined that our current radio tower, antenna, and engineering building located on Smuggler Mountain was in need of immediate replacement. Planning for and completing this work in 2024 will be a critical project for Aspen Public Radio.

Public Events

Planning is already underway for community events in the year ahead, including the second annual Aspen Psychedelic Symposium, a special partnership with Colorado Mountain College around the 2024 Common Reader, another summer Lawn Bash including our nonprofit volunteer fair, and a new symposium in the Fall to explore backcountry safety.

Community Conversations

We are a connector, collaborator, and convenor in our valley. Aspen Public Radio is proud to present select public lectures, discussions, and conversations thanks to a remarkable collection of community partners –with many local recordings broadcast Sunday nights at 7 p.m. In 2024, we will work to expand our schedule of live broadcasts and recorded events by bringing in new partners throughout the region.

Emergency Preparedness

Public radio stations understand what needs to be in place to best respond to a critical real-time emergency in our community, like a wildfire, major flooding, school shooting threat, or mass shooter incident. When the power goes out, and the internet is down, tune into Aspen Public Radio for the latest breaking news and information to keep you and your family safe.

2022 Awards and Honors

In April, Aspen Public Radio was recognized for its outstanding journalism by the [Colorado Broadcasters Association](#) and the Society of Professional Journalists, honoring work in 2022. We received top honors, or first place, in both the “Best News Feature, Report or Series” category for Eleanor Bennett’s story, “Jahir Rodas cuts his first Christmas tree and keeps his grandmother’s memory alive” and “Best Sports Feature” category for Halle Zander’s story, “Paralympic athlete returns to Snowmass, helps his students learn to ski.” Both reporters took home this top honor, in the same categories, in 2021.

The Society of Professional Journalists (SPJ) Colorado chapter presents its regional Top of the Rockies contest on behalf of SPJ chapters in Colorado, Utah, New Mexico and Wyoming. [In the SPJ contest, Aspen Public Radio was recognized with four awards overall](#), including first-place in the “A&E/Food Feature” category for “Local connection helps a renowned pianist find refuge from Russia-Ukraine war” by Kaya Williams, second-place in the “Sports Feature” category for “Lori Spence paves the way as the first woman to lead Aspen Highlands Ski Patrol” by Eleanor Bennett, and two third-place awards for reporting by Halle Zander and Eleanor Bennett.



In May, [Aspen Public Radio was recognized with three Regional Edward R. Murrow Awards](#), for Eleanor Bennett’s story, “Jahir Rodas cuts his first Christmas tree and keeps his grandmother’s memory alive” in the “Feature Reporting” category, and Halle Zander’s stories “Teen rescues and resuscitates friend caught in the Cascades on Independence Pass, credits CPR training” in the “Hard News” category, and “Uneven Landscapes: Spanish Emergency Alerts in the Roaring Fork Valley” for “Excellence in Diversity, Equity and Inclusion.”

[In August it was announced that Halle Zander’s story “Teen Rescues and Resuscitates Friend Caught in the Cascades on Independence Pass, Credits CPR Training” would receive a National Edward R. Murrow award as the top Hard News story of 2022 across all small market radio stations in the country.](#)

“Edward R. Murrow awards are celebrated throughout our industry as honoring the best of the best,” said Aspen Public Radio Executive Director Breeze Richardson. “For Aspen Public Radio to be the only radio station in Colorado of any size to receive an award helps bring awareness to the phenomenal work this newsroom is doing everyday in service to Aspen and the valley.”

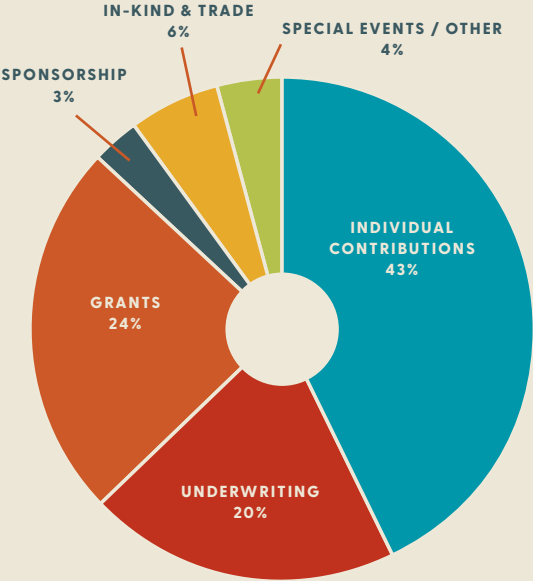

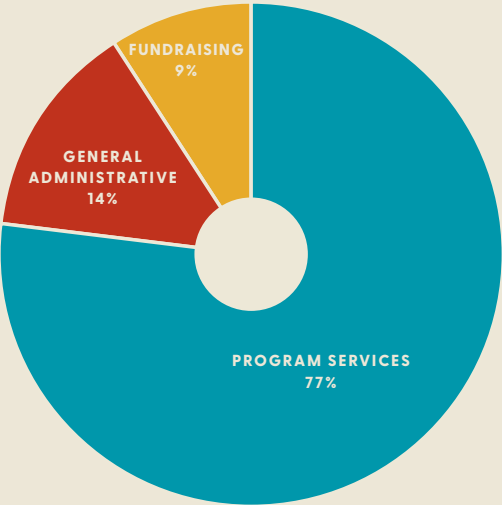

Listener Survey Highlights

The Fall 2023 Listener Survey took place in October to help the station understand how we can best serve the news and information needs of listeners and grow Aspen Public Radio as a leading public broadcast journalism service on Colorado's western slope. **Here is some of what we learned.**

58% of survey respondents have been listening to Aspen Public Radio for 15 years or more.

Car radios continue to be the most popular way to listen, followed by home radio listening, web / streaming, apps, and podcasts.

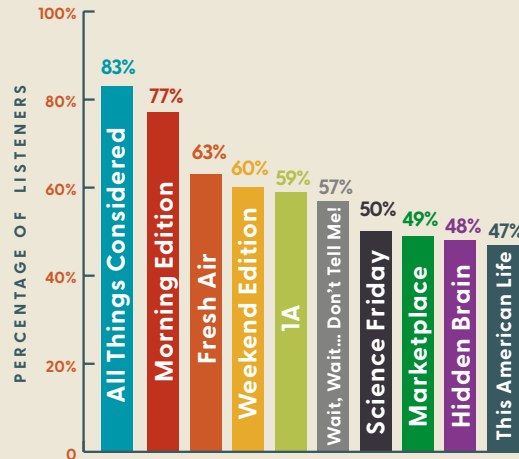
85% of respondents live here full-time, **11%** live here part-time, and **4%** like to visit and listen to Aspen Public Radio to stay connected to the Roaring Fork Valley.

60% of responding listeners report they rely on Aspen Public Radio for local news, with an additional **25%** reporting that it is their main source for local news.

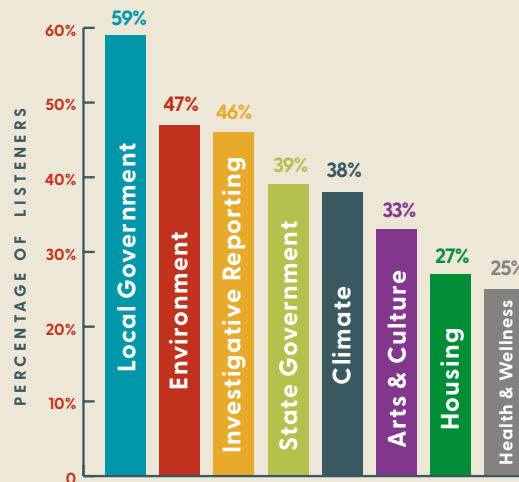

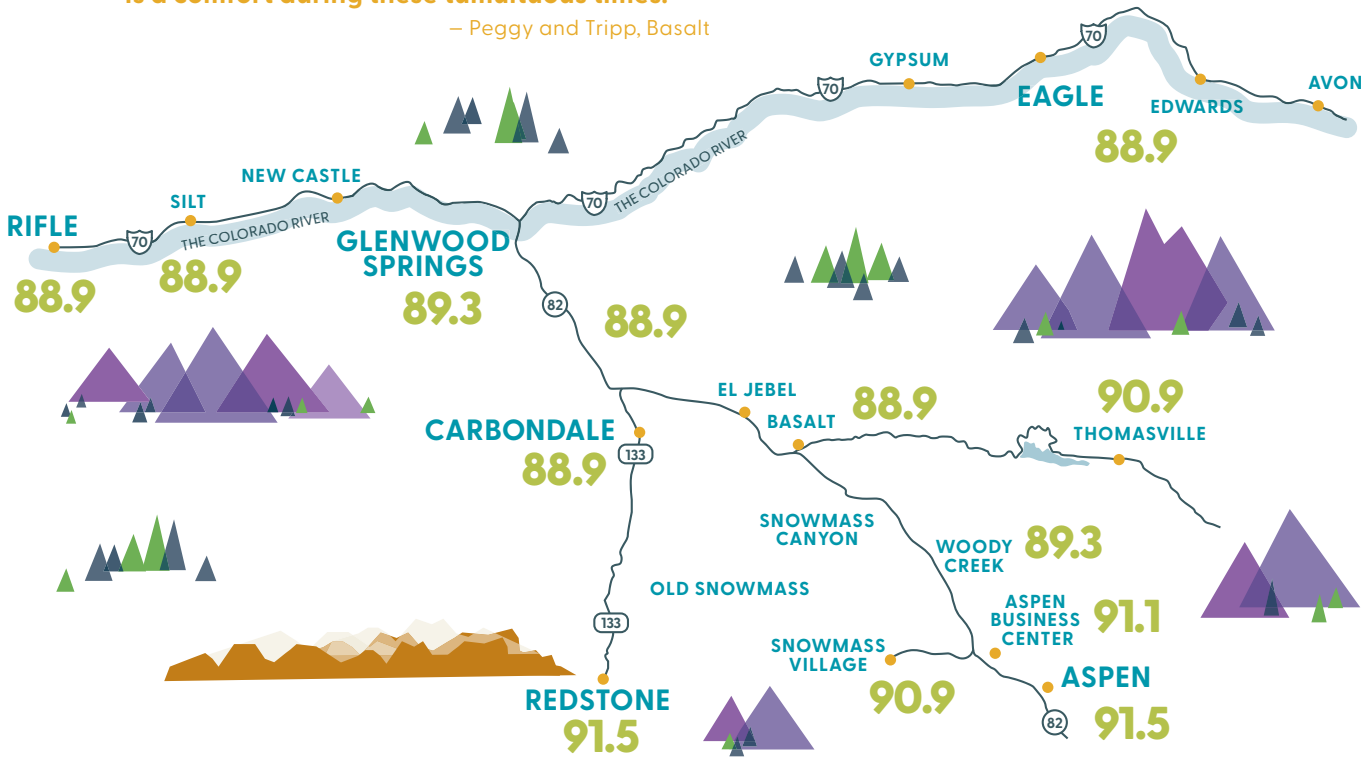
Frequency Map

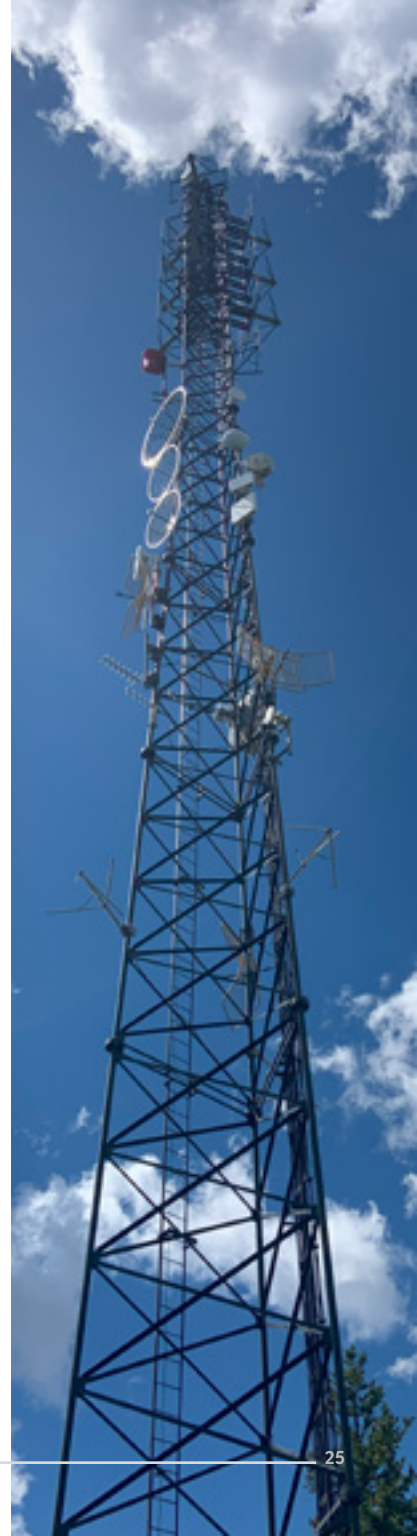
