Dreaming of a Jewish Christmas tells the amazing story of a group of Jewish songwriters who wrote the soundtrack to Christmas. "White Christmas," "Silver Bells," "Winter Wonderland," "The Christmas Song" (chestnuts roasting), "I'll Be Home for Christmas," "Do You Hear What I Hear," "A Holly Jolly Christmas" and more, are all songs that have become synonymous with Christmas and they were also all written by Jewish composers.

This holiday special explores the origins of these and many other Christmas songs, written by the most unlikely of songwriters. "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" was, in fact, penned by a Jewish writer and the inspiration for his little reindeer came from the loss of his wife and the love he had for his daughter.

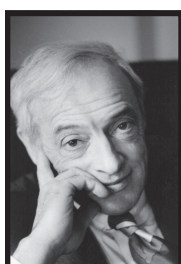

Groucho & Cavett

American Masters "Groucho & Cavett" explores the enduring friendship between television personality Dick Cavett and iconic comedian Groucho Marx. Cavett, a writer for Jack Parr on *The Tonight Show*, met Marx at the funeral of playwright George S. Kaufman in 1961. When Cavett made the transition from writer to comedian in 1965, he was encouraged and mentored by Marx.

In 1968, Cavett became the host of his own talk show and Marx became a frequent guest capturing what Cavett calls, "the last of Groucho's greatness." **American Masters** "Groucho & Cavett" chronicles the pair's relationship through new interviews with Cavett, footage from Marx's visits to *The Dick Cavett Show* and other rare recordings.

South Side Chicago's National Teachers Academy (NTA), a high-performing elementary school, is considered a beacon for Black children. The school has served as a safe haven for children and a community bedrock in "The South Loop," Chicago's fastest growing neighborhood.

When NTA is threatened to be transformed into a high school favoring the needs of the community's wealthier residents, African American parents-turned-organizers, alongside students and staff advocate to keep the school open.

Race, class, gentrification, power, privilege, and politics all collide to create discord amongst a community that wants the best possible education for their children.

In a Different Key

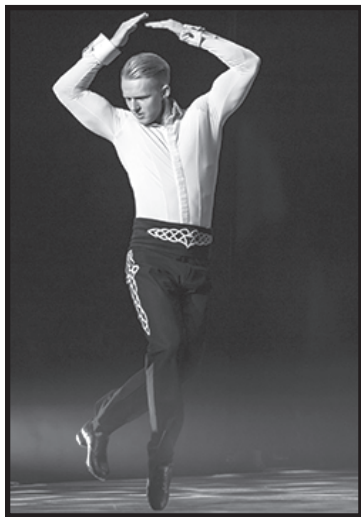
In a Different Key follows a mother as she tracks down the first person ever diagnosed with autism to learn if his life story holds promise for her own autistic son. Her journey exposes a startling record of cruelty and kindness alike, framed by forces like race, money and privilege—but leads to hope that more communities are learning to have the backs of people on the spectrum.

Donald Triplett was deemed "Case 1" in a 1943 article that reported on what is now called Autism Spectrum Disorder, or autism. He has lived in his hometown of Forest, Mississippi his whole life, which Zucker and fellow journalist John Donvan described as "long, happy, and surprising."

Zucker and Donvan first established a relationship with Triplett when they co-wrote the 2010 *The Atlantic* magazine story, "Autism's First Child." They also co-wrote the book *In a Different Key: The Story of Autism*, which became a finalist for the 2017 Pulitzer Prize for general nonfiction.

Demystifying Detox will be broadcast on 3-1 Friday, the 2nd at 7:00 p.m.

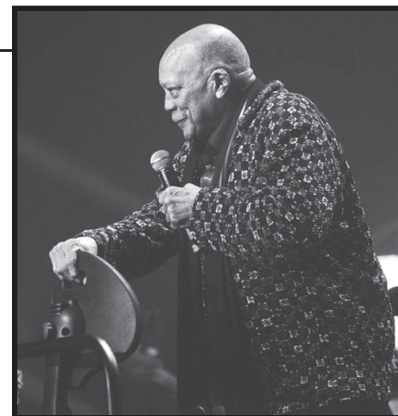
The Musicians' Green Book: *An Enduring Legacy*

Celebrate the vibrant Jazz, R&B and Soul music of African American artists who, during segregation, created the foundation of modern American music. Navigating the injustices of racial segregation was difficult and dangerous—even for renowned Black artists like Duke Ellington, Ella Fitzgerald, Little Richard or Sam Cooke. Like many other Black Americans, they relied on Victor Hugo Green's *Negro Travelers' Green Book*, a directory of lodgings, restaurants and entertainment venues where African Americans were safe and welcomed.

Green's book was a guide to a parallel world of vibrant Black neighborhoods where Black entrepreneurs created thriving businesses that served and sustained Black patrons and artists. Informally known as the Chitlin' Circuit, these music venues included glamorous theaters, swinging dance halls and rural juke joints, where icons and rising stars alike honed their craft and won audience acclaim.

The Musicians' Green Book: An Enduring Legacy features an exciting mix of classic songs performed by legendary and contemporary stars and candid interviews with performers, celebrities and notable musicians who were a part of the circuit.

The Musicians' Green Book: An Enduring Legacy will be broadcast on 3-1 Sunday, the 4th at 5:00 p.m.

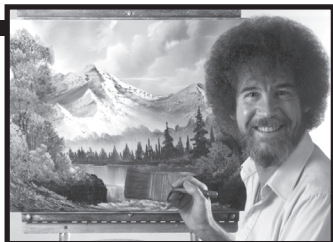


Quincy Jones: *A Musical Celebration In Paris*

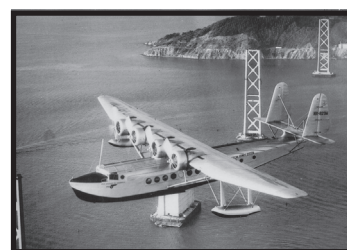


Each hour-long episode educates and inspires viewers about the nature of bees, ranging from their fascinating anatomy to deadly group aggression and surprising hive intelligence.

The China Clipper

Across the Pacific

Across the Pacific is a three-part series with four main characters—airline executive Juan Trippe, pilot Charles Lindbergh, airplane builder Igor Sikorsky and radio engineer Hugo Leuteritz—who separately struggle to find a place in post-World War I aviation. Their struggles illuminate the challenges all aviation pioneers face in these early, uncertain days. After repeated setbacks, the four men join forces and, capitalizing on the Air Mail Act and the aviation mania triggered by Lindbergh’s 1927 transatlantic flight, set out to build an airline to South America: Pan Am.

They began with a single, 90-mile airmail route, from Key West, Florida, to Havana, Cuba. Eight years later, they were crossing the world’s biggest ocean at its widest point, nearly 9,000 miles. It was a great milestone in aviation history: the 1935 crossing of the Pacific Ocean by a Pan American Airways flying boat known as the China Clipper.

Across the Pacific airs on 3-2 Fridays at 10:00 p.m. beginning the 2nd and Thursdays at 7:00 p.m. beginning the 15th. It airs on 3-1 Sundays at 11:00 p.m. beginning the 18th.

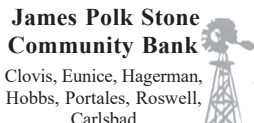
