<u>HIRING</u>

- WLRN Management Liaison- Senior Management Position was posted twice and was listed on the Miami-Dade County Public School's website (one of the largest employers in Florida), the Public Media Jobs Board, Indeed, LinkedIn, Monster, The Association for Women in Communications, and Public Relations Society of America. None had requested notifications. Nine people applied, of which two candidates were interviewed. The ultimate hire learned of the position from Linkedin. Date of hire was October 31, 2022.
- Assistant Chief Engineer- The position was posted twice and with licensee Miami-Dade County Public School's website & Twitter account (one of the largest employers in Florida), TVjobs.com and LinkedIn. A large and diverse pool of applicants applied and six were interviewed over two listings. Three received finalist interviews. The ultimate hire learned of the position from LinkedIn. Date of hire was July 12, 2023.

INITIATIVES

Training

Licensee's Management level personnel, including managers at the Stations, are provided EEO training to ensure Equal Employment Opportunity and prevent discrimination.

All Licensee Station employees received training on how to identify forms of harassment in the workplace, and how to report suspected harassment through a required webinar provided by the Corporation for Public Broadcasting.
