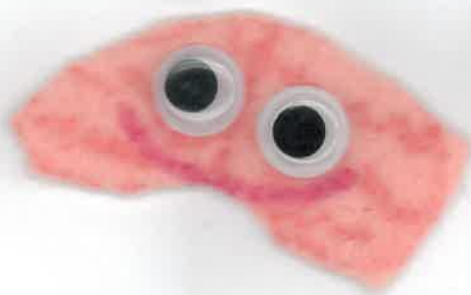


My Story:

I turned and stared too. As snowflakes danced in the sky, I was imagining wonderful stories to write. Ideas were buzzing around inside my head.



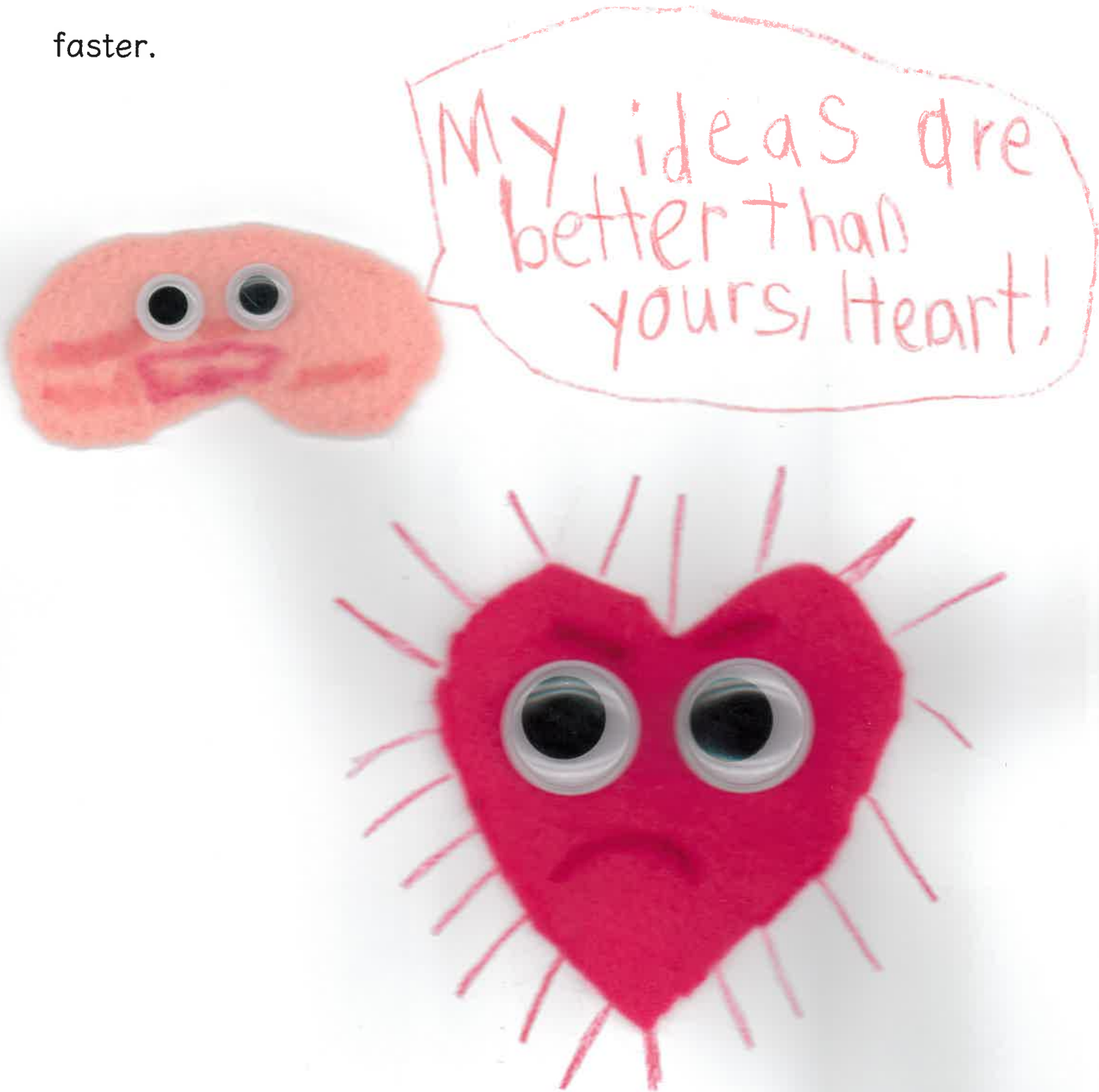
Brain thought, "Write a story about snowflake twins."

Brain reacted, "No, no! Write about a jellyfish!"

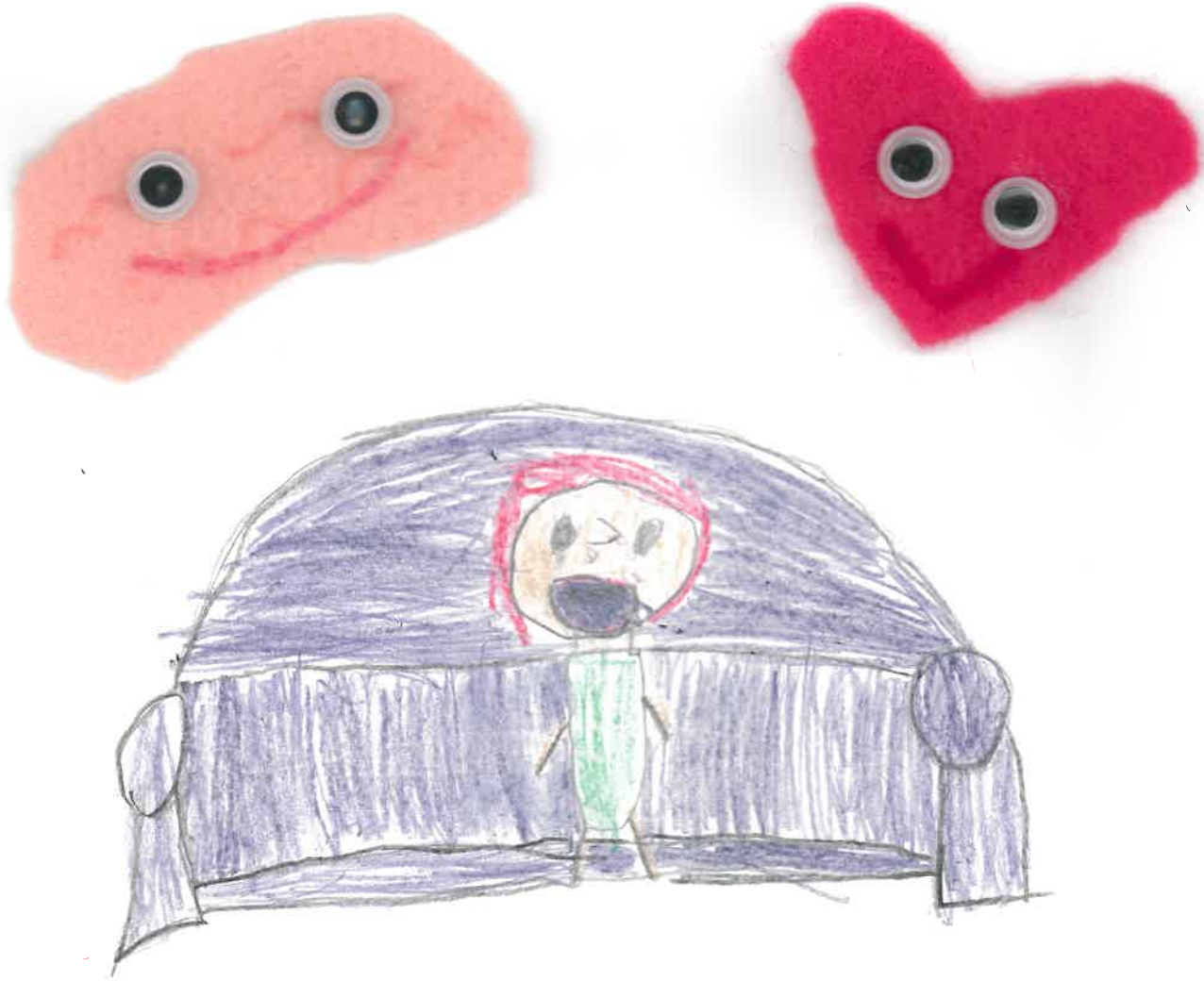


Brain and Heart continued to fight like brother and sister. "My ideas are better than yours, Heart!"

Heart felt overloaded and pounded harder and faster.

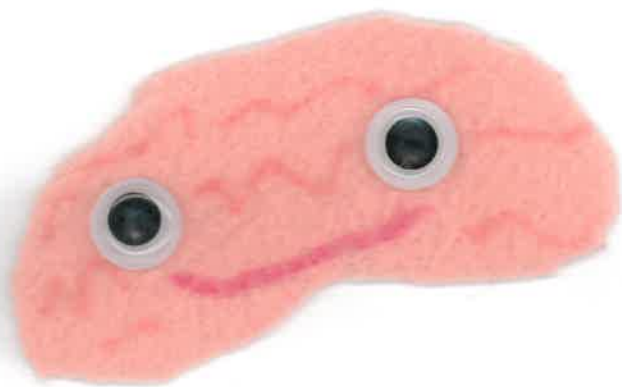


I sat back down on the couch and screamed, "Brain!
