**THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:**

**COUNT 1**

24 On or about December 22, 2025, in the District of Arizona, within the confines of  
25 the Navajo Nation Indian Reservation, Indian Country, the defendant, STANLEY  
26 BEGAY, JR., an Indian, did intentionally, knowingly and recklessly assault the victim,  
27 C.G., resulting in serious bodily injury.
