## Wuhan Wuhan

The 35th anniversary season of **POV (Point of View)**, America's longest running documentary series, opens with the heart rendering observational film "Wuhan Wuhan," about the first wave of COVID-19, in the city where the mysterious virus was first discovered. The documentary goes beyond the statistics and salacious headlines to provide a human experience to the early months of



the pandemic through the stories of frontline medical workers, patients, and ordinary citizens.

During February and March 2020, two months into the city's lockdown, hospital medical staff in Wuhan are scrambling for PPE (Personal Protective Equipment for Infection Control), some using their own money to buy

the necessary protective gear. Doctors and nurses write their names and pin pictures of themselves to their chests so their patients can recognize them.

As the deadly coronavirus evolves, city residents and volunteers from other provinces provide necessary resources as Wuhan grapples with an invisible, deadly killer. Amidst the height of the pandemic, filmmakers have unprecedented access into firsthand accounts of local medical personnel and selfless volunteers—each with a unique perspective to the crisis at hand.

"Wuhan Wuhan" focuses on five compelling stories: a soft-hearted ER doctor; an unflappable ICU nurse from the COVID-19 hospital; a compassionate volunteer psychologist; a tenacious mother and her young son, who are both COVID-19 patients; and a volunteer driver for medical workers and his nine-month pregnant wife, whose heartfelt story forms the backbone of this film.

"Wuhan Wuhan" on **POV** airs on 3-2 Monday, the 11th at 9:00 p.m. Watch it on 3-1 Friday, the 15th at 9:00 p.m.



## In the Footsteps of ...

**In the Footsteps of ...** is a four-part series that follows Gyles Brandreth as he scours the United Kingdom to understand what inspired six of Britain's greatest writers: Charles Dickens, Jane Austen (shown above), Thomas Hardy and the Brontë Sisters—Charlotte, Emily and Anne.

Although the squalor of London's much-fabled "Dickensian streets" are now gone, Gyles discovers many places still standing today that inspired Dickens' stories and shaped his life. The formative experiences of the young, impoverished Charles influenced some of his greatest works—*Oliver Twist*, *Great Expectations*, *David Copperfield*, and *Little Dorrit*.

Although Jane Austen had humble beginnings in Steventon, she was given an insight into the aristocracy for her novels through her brother, Edward, who was adopted by a wealthy family. Gyles visits the Austen Museum, the cottage where Jane lived and wrote all of her six novels, where he reads some early "teen fiction" that shed light on how these novels of female empowerment went on to conquer the world.

The West Yorkshire moors is a landscape synonymous with the stories of Charlotte, Emily and Anne Brontë, who spent almost their entire lives in an area that shaped them and they have shaped in turn. The parsonage, known today as the Brontë Museum, is where the sisters lived and their imaginations flourished to write literary classics such as *Jane Eyre*, *Wuthering Heights* and *The Tenant of Wildfell Hall*.

The sisters were also inspired by their own lives and experiences—from their miserable time at school and the treatment of women in Victorian society to their experience of mental illness and of death.

Thomas Hardy lived most of his life in the Southwest of England, the setting for his most famous novels—*Tess of the D'Urbervilles*, *The Mayor of Casterbridge*, *Jude the Obscure* and his breakthrough novel *Far from the Madding Crowd*. Gyles visits the locations Hardy describes that are influenced by real places, including Stonehenge, which was the dramatic setting for the end of *Tess of the D'Urbervilles*. Finally, Gyles explores Hardy's personal life and troubled marriage that influenced his stories, issues and characters.

## THE GREEN PLANET

**The Green Planet** is a new five-part documentary that reveals the strange and wonderful world of plants as never before. The series could be described as planet Earth from the perspective of plants. As host Sir David Attenborough explains: "Every mouthful of food that we eat, every lungful of air that we breathe, depends on plants."

Living secret, unseen lives, plants are often overlooked. Yet they are as aggressive, competitive and dramatic as animals—locked in life-and-death struggles for food and light, taking part in fierce battles for territory and desperately trying to reproduce and scatter their young.

Sir David travels from deserts to mountains, from rainforests to the frozen north, to present a fresh understanding of how plants live their lives. He meets the largest living things that have ever existed, trees that care for each other, plants that hunt animals and plants that breed so fast they could cover the planet in a matter of months. He finds time travelers—seeds that can outlive civilizations and plants that remain unchanged for decades.

## Grantchester 7th Season

Season 7 of “Grantchester” on **Masterpiece** premieres with plenty of new baffling cases for DI George ‘Geordie’ Keating (Robson Green) and Reverend Will Davenport (Tom Brittney) to join forces and solve.

It’s a sweltering summer in 1959 and Rev. Will Davenport has a lot of weddings to preside over. One bride is Adele Fitzgerald (Anna Wilson Jones) who lives in a stately home with her spinster sister Maude (Emma Cuniffe). When the body of their errant brother, Lord Edmund, is found on the estate, Will joins DI George Keating to investigate all the possible family secrets.

Romance might also be in the cards for Will when he meets an enigmatic woman at a jazz club, while Geordie has a plan to win back estranged wife Cathy. But are both men headed for happy-ever-after or heartbreak?

## Berlin Wall: Countdown to 1961/1989

The Berlin Wall divided Germany—and Europe—for nearly 30 years. Like other walls around the world, this inhumane structure tore families apart and destroyed lives. **The Berlin Wall: Countdown to 1961/1989**, a two-part documentary, reveals a very personal perspective on this physical representation of the Cold War.

On August 13, 1961, Berliners woke up on a Sunday morning to find their city divided by a wall. That day became known as “Barbed Wire Sunday,” marking a peak in the era of the Cold War. It felt like a complete surprise to many, but key moments in the preceding year made clear that something was brewing.

On August 5, 1961, author Brigitte Reimann noted in her diary: “Yesterday evening was terrible. The Berlin crisis is escalating. We are once again teetering on the edge of war.” West Berlin camera man Dieter Hoffmann filmed the events of August 13 as they unfolded, capturing the now famous moment when 19-year-old East German

police officer Conrad Schumann leaped into the annals of history with his “Jump to Freedom.”

The fall of the Berlin Wall on the evening of November 9, 1989 also came as a complete surprise to East and West Germans, and the entire world. How did this historic moment come to be? The film identifies ten milestones, key political and societal events from 1988 to 1989 which, like a countdown, ultimately led to the opening and fall of the Berlin Wall.

## The Man Who Destroyed OSCAR WILDE

Oscar Wilde became one of the most popular playwrights in London during the early 1890s. He was known for his brilliant wit and his acclaimed works, which included *The Picture of Dorian Gray* and *The Importance of Being Earnest*.

In **The Man Who Destroyed Oscar Wilde**, Merlin Holland, grandson of Oscar Wilde, tells the epic story of the famous playwright’s courtroom duel and downfall at the hands of Edward Carson, a brilliant attorney who Wilde had once called an “old friend.” Carson’s brutal 1895 cross-examination of Wilde is one of the most famous trials in British history.

Wilde and Carson were born in the same year and attended Trinity College where they knew each other well. Yet they were fated to meet in a cataclysmic clash years later in the most famous court in England, the Old Bailey, in what was described as the most scandalous case of Victorian times.

The result of the trial was disastrous for the Wilde family. It ended in Wilde’s ruin



and led to his imprisonment from 1895 to 1897 for his homosexuality, which was a criminal offence in Britain until 1967. With his imprisonment, Wilde’s wife, Constance (Merlin’s grandmother), left England with their children and changed their surname to Holland to try to protect them.

Wilde emerged from prison a broken man. He never recovered and died a few years later, alone and in poverty.

## COBRA: Cyberwar

**COBRA** follows British Prime Minister Robert Sutherland (Robert Carlyle) and his Cabinet Office Briefing Room A (COBRA) committee, comprised of leading contingency planners and senior politicians, as they navigate the difficulties in overcoming one major national crisis after another.

The first season aired in late 2020 and followed the global and political fallout from a devastating solar storm.

In season 2, **COBRA: Cyberwar**, an 8-part series, an assassination on British soil unleashes a chain of events that threatens to develop into a crisis even more serious than the one from which the country has recently emerged. An apparently invisible global enemy, not playing by the rules and operating outside national boundaries, seems bent on destruction and nobody really knows who is a friend and who is a foe.

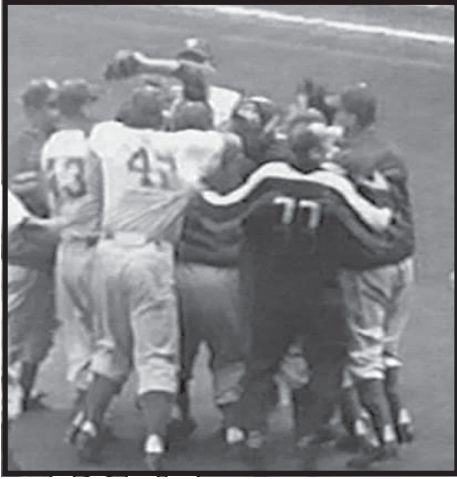



## The Great Muslim American Road Trip

Buckle up for a cross-country journey along historic Route 66 in **The Great Muslim American Road Trip**. Who knew that one of the first non-indigenous people to set foot in North America was a Moroccan explorer or that a Syrian camel driver helped survey the very road that has provided millions of American tourists their kicks on Route 66?

The 3-part series follows a young Muslim American couple—Mona and Sebastian—as they explore America's "Mother Road" and its surrounding Muslim communities on drive from Chicago to Los Angeles. In "Back on the Road Again: Arizona, Nevada, California," Mona and Sebastian visit the grave of a famous Syrian-born camel driver, find traces of America's first Muslim explorer from the 1500s, and stumble upon an unexpected community of Muslims in Las Vegas.

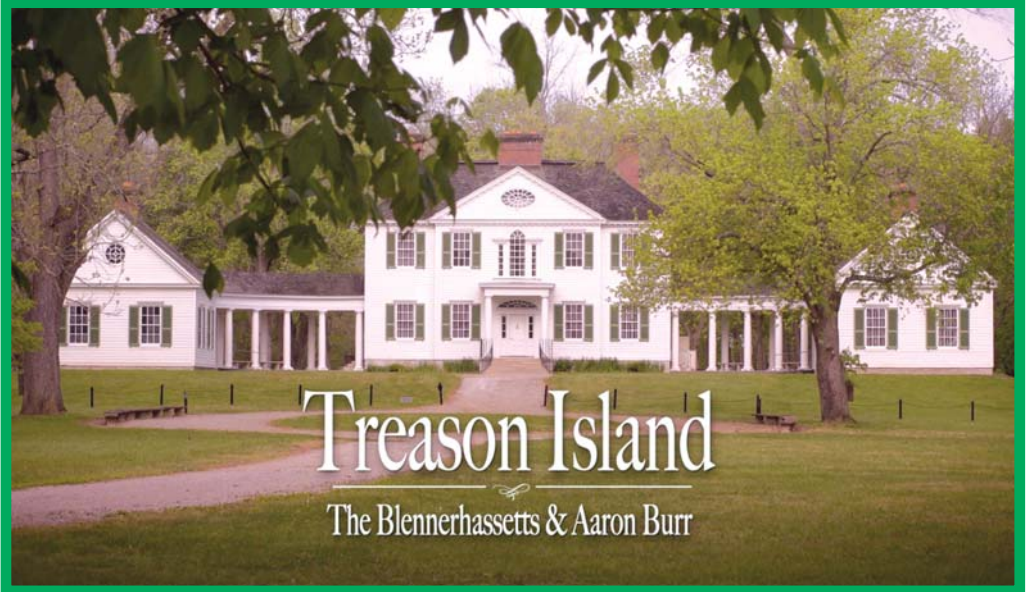

**Treason Island** is the story of Anglo-Irish immigrants Harman and Margaret Blennerhassett and their involvement with America's fallen founder, Aaron Burr. Blennerhassett had fled Ireland due to his involvement with the Irish revolution.

In 1798, he purchased the eastern end of a 4-mile-long island in the Ohio River. There, in the midst of the unchartered wilderness, the Blennerhassetts went all out, building a luxury mansion comparable to George Washington's Mt. Vernon. Oriental carpets, Parisian china, oil paintings, sterling silver door fixtures, a 2-acre flower garden— this elegant mansion was one-of-a-kind, and the only luxury mansion west of the Appalachians.

Blennerhassett and his wife were known far and wide for their indulgent parties. Plenty of high-profile people visited the island. But in 1805, one of the most infamous figures of the early American republic arrived: Aaron Burr. His political career was already faltering; the previous year he had killed Alexander Hamilton in a duel, and he was looking to leave the country.

The Blennerhassetts became involved with Burr's political aspirations, leading to their ruin and to "The Trial of the Century" on charges of treason. Today, most historians agree that Burr and Blennerhassett were preparing to invade Spanish territory in what is today Texas. That in itself was not necessarily illegal, or even looked down upon by many Americans. But, in early 1806, Burr contacted the government of Imperial Spain, laying out plans not just to break off the western part of the United States, but possibly to invade Washington D.C.



In 1811, the island mansion burned to the ground. But in 1973, archaeologists discovered its buried foundations and, after extensive research, the Blennerhassett Island State Park and Blennerhassett historical foundation rebuilt a replica of the mansion, and it's open to visitors.
