

The Great Chicago Fire

On October 10, 1871, Chicagoans awoke to an unrecognizable landscape. Forty-eight hours earlier, there had been a vibrant city of ornate civic buildings, grand hotels, and cultural institutions. Now, there was nothing but a smoking pile of rubble stretching for miles on end. Many wondered if the city could recover. And how did tensions between the city's elite and the immigrant poor lead to the wrong person being accused of starting the blaze?

The Great Chicago Fire: American Stories tells the dramatic story of a defining moment in Chicago history - "the Great Fire of 1871," when the city faced destruction, rebuilt, and laid the groundwork for a thriving future.

Benjamin Franklin

Benjamin Franklin, a four-hour documentary by Ken Burns, returns to PBS. The series explores the life and work of one of the most consequential figures in American history—a prolific writer and publisher, a groundbreaking scientist and inventor, a world-renowned diplomat and a signer of both the Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution.

Franklin, whose life has been celebrated as a quintessential American story, was anything but typical. His 84 years spanned nearly the entirety of the 18th century, an epoch of revolutionary change in science, technology, literature, politics and government—change that Franklin himself helped to advance.

He launched the first public library in America, organized a volunteer fire company, and founded an academy that eventually became the University of Pennsylvania. His annual publi-"Poor Richard's Almanack," cation. set a model for future humorists such as Mark Twain and contained maxims that are still part of our shared lexicon.




