Guitar virtuoso **Denny Breau** blends jazz, country, and blues with effortless skill and charm. Indie-folk duo **Oshima Brothers** captivate with their lush harmonies and genre-bending creativity, while roots-rock powerhouses **The Mallett Brothers Band** deliver the high-energy sound that has made them one of Maine's most beloved bands. Master fiddlers **Don and Cindy Roy** keep Maine's Franco-American music traditions alive with unmatched spirit, **Paul Sullivan** delivers a wonderful jazz performance on the piano, and the lively **Erica Brown Band** raises the roof and gets the room rocking. Multi-media performance artist **Jason Brown** – also known as **Firefly (on the cover)** – infuses his music with Wabanaki culture and storytelling. Country favorite **Joan Kennedy** brings her heartfelt songs and powerhouse voice, and jazz clarinetist **Brad Terry** and guitarist **Peter Herman** add a joyful, virtuosic energy. Together all these artists showcase the depth, diversity, and soul of the Maine music scene – one performance at a time.

Singer, songwriter, and storyteller, **Carolyn Currie** is the warm and insightful host of **Sound Waves**. With a career rooted in Maine's vibrant music scene, Carolyn brings both passion and curiosity to every conversation. Her deep understanding of





music, combined with her approachable charm, makes her the perfect companion for viewers as they experience intimate performances and discover the heart of Maine's diverse musical landscape.

Teaming up with the Emmy award-winning Maine Public production team behind **Sound Waves** is veteran producer and music industry expert, **Con Fullam** who brings decades of experience to the series. With a career that includes founding and producing the acclaimed Pihcintu Multinational Girls Choir and writing the beloved holiday classic "Maine Christmas Song," Con has a proven talent for capturing the soul of music and bringing it to audiences with clarity and warmth. Captured in 4K, **Sound Waves** not only looks great, but it also sounds incredible, thanks to being recorded at The Studio Portland, one of Maine's premier recording facilities. ■

**Miss Scarlet** *airs at 8:00 pm*

WHEN WE LAST SAW ELIZA SCARLET, her life seemed out of balance. A new Detective Inspector had taken charge at Scotland Yard; one with no intention of enlisting her services. But true to form, Eliza didn't back down. Through grit and brilliance, she earned the DI's respect. And Eliza's maternal housekeeper decided to marry coroner Barnabus Potts as Season 5 wrapped – what will that mean for the household? Now as a new chapter begins, will

Eliza continue to pour everything into the job, or will she attend to her personal life? Kate Phillips returns as Eliza Scarlet, Victorian London's trailblazing female private detective with Tom Durant-Pritchard as DI Alexander Blake. Six, hour-long episodes offer flavors of the Victorian era, unique murder cases, and the ongoing storylines of headstrong Eliza Scarlet, single parent DI Blake, and the newly married couple, Ivy and Barnabus Potts, among others.

SEASON 6 TAKES VIEWERS BACK TO THE ROLLING HILLS of the Yorkshire Dales, where life in Darrowby is starting to find its rhythm again as the war in Europe winds down. It's 1945, and the Skeldale family is stepping into a new chapter – one shaped by change, hope, and the opportunities that come with a more peaceful future. While Europe celebrates victory, life at Skeldale House remains far from calm. James is wishing for a greater sense of peace at the surgery as he juggles vet work with a busy family life and an exceptionally challenging Siegfried. Helen's enjoying time with young Jimmy and Rosie, but big changes are afoot at Heston Grange. Tristan is home from the war, and Mrs. Hall works hard to bring everybody back together and tries to restore harmony. The show continues to celebrate what it always has: community, compassion, and connection. The war may have left its mark, but the people of Darrowby keep showing up for each other – and their creatures. ■

**Finding Your Roots with Henry Louis Gates, Jr.**

*Season premiere Tuesday, January 6, 8:00 pm*

THE SERIES THAT TRACES FAMILY TREES and the history associated with them returns with all new guests ranging from actors and musicians to filmmakers and businessmen. In the upcoming twelfth season of **Finding Your Roots**, 20 new celebrity guests will sit down with Dr. Henry Louis Gates, Jr. to learn about their families and the journeys of their ancestors dating back hundreds of years. Through ten new episodes, Gates and his team use genealogical detective work and cutting-edge DNA analysis to trace the family trees of their celebrity guests, telling stories that shine a light on America's fundamental diversity and compelling similarities. As the pages turn in each guest's book of life, emotional revelations give way to complex questions about identity. America Ferrera (pictured) and Darren Criss are featured in the first episode on January 6.



**Breaking the Deadlock: A Matter of Life and Death**

*Tuesday, January 20, 9:00 pm*

WHAT DOES "FREEDOM" MEAN – and what is the role of government – when people face life and death choices? As with many other complex issues, Americans are divided in their views regarding the limits of personal autonomy. In an hour-long special, author and Professor of Law Aaron Tang moderates the conversation among a panel of experts with very different views. They take on a hypothetical scenario that raises questions about reproductive rights, as well as our right to die at a time of our choosing. The series brings together a varied panel of prominent voices from political, cultural, and legal arenas to explore ethical dilemmas drawn from real life. This groundbreaking public affairs series is designed to encourage civil dialogue today when public conversation is so polarized. ■

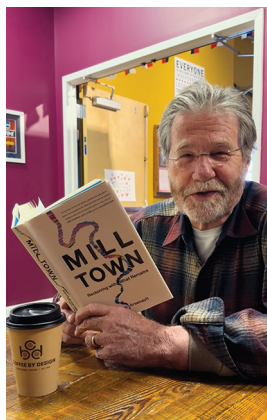
