As you know, the Community and Employment Support (CES) Waiver provides personalized services for individuals with intellectual or development disabilities to live independently and find employment. The CES Waiver isn't just a social service—it's workforce strategy, a cost-management tool, and a quality-of-life initiative that supports our most vulnerable while strengthening the broader economy.

In Arkansas' current waiver, the Department of Human Services serves a certain number of patients based on a mix of federal and state dollars. Any additional patients beyond that number would require more funding. As this office prepares for the next legislative session of the General Assembly and to resubmit the state's CES Waiver for approval in 2027, we will keep your thoughts in mind.
