In response to your letter dated April 14th, 2026.

To Answer the allegations:

I mailed a confirmation notice that was designed by the BOE for verification of address or change of address.(attached)

Put them on a list to send to Township Clerks for their follow up.

Got the information off the QVF Voting History from a list of Registered Voter Report by Jurisdiction registered by 4-8-2026. Deemed it Reliable.

Got information of Change of Address USPCOA Work Book. Deemed it Reliable.

Followed Chapter 4: Voter Status Changes and Notices

As to Sub Rule 3 that was the intent of mailing the verification cards. I sent the list and offered the cards for the Township Clerks to follow up with recording information into the QVF.

- Reasoning to help the Townships clean up their Qualified Voter files by absorbing the cost and labor at the county level.
Many of our Townships have limited resources to accomplish these tasks.
- Information from the QVF registered Voter Reports and the Post Card Generated by Election Source to BOE specs.

Every voter on the report was verified as to address changes and voting history. All information came from the QVF. I deemed that the information acquired was “reliable information”.

- I relied on the Township clerks to follow those procedures outlined in the Election Officials Manual regarding any address change activity using the cards that were returned.
- Attached are the lists sent to the township clerks to date. QVF being updated is responsibility of the Township Clerks.
- I used the last 2 Major elections as a bench mark for the post card. Many voters have moved out of our Jurisdiction and those are the voters that need to be flagged by the Township Clerks.
- Do not know why this verbiage was not on the post card since the BOE designed this card.
- The post card did state Notice of Change of Address or a Notice of Cancellation. Again, designed by the BOE.
- No Agreements were signed.
- Have not finished all Townships. Attached those who have had post cards go out.

My intent was to expedite the information and absorb the cost for the Township Clerks. The Majority of feedback I have received from the Voter’s who have received the cards is “It’s About Time”.
