Little Bird

~ Premieres Thursday, November 2, 10:00 pm ~

A NEW SIX-PART DRAMA explores universal themes of resilience in the face of trauma and loss. It follows an Indigenous woman as she embarks on a path to find the hidden truth of her family history.

Removed from her home at age 5 in Long Pine Reserve in Saskatchewan, Bezhig Little Bird is adopted into a Montreal Jewish family, becoming Esther Rosenblum. Now in her 20s, Bezhig longs for the family she lost and to fill in the missing pieces. Her quest lands her in the Canadian prairies. As she begins to track down her siblings, she unravels the mystery behind her adoption and discovers that her apprehension was connected to a racist government policy, now known as the “Sixties Scoop.” Her sense of identity shatters, and she is forced to reckon with who she is and who she wants to become.

The character-driven drama features Darla Contois as Bezhig Little Bird and Lisa Edelstein as Esther’s adoptive mother, Golda Rosenblum, plus a talented cast of Indigenous actors. **Little Bird** was filmed in and around Winnipeg, in Brokenhead Ojibway Nation on Treaty 1 territory and in Sioux Valley Dakota Nation. 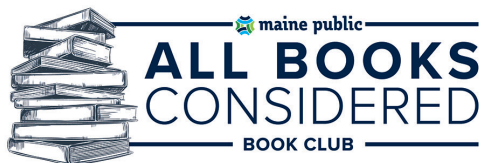

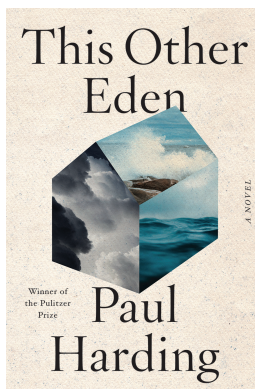

Dawnland airs on *Thursday, November 2, at 9:00 p.m. and Saturday, November 4, at 2:00 p.m.*: In Maine, a historic investigation – the first government-sanctioned Truth and Reconciliation Commission (TRC) in the United States – began a bold journey: to hear the untold narrative of Indigenous child removal in the United States. For over two years, Native and non-Native commissioners traveled across Maine. They gathered testimony to the devastating impact of the state’s child welfare practices on families in Maine’s tribal communities.

On *Thursday, November 9, at 9:00 p.m. and Saturday, November 11, at 2:00 p.m.*, three short films reflect Native American history: **Weckuwapasihitit** (Those Yet to Come) – Revitalizing cultural

practices kept from their elders, Peskotomuhkati young people lead an inter-generational process of healing through the reclamation of athasikuwi-pisun, “tattoo medicine.” **Bounty** – As an act of resistance, remembrance, and a step toward justice, members of the Penobscot Nation traveled to Boston to read the 1755 proclamation encouraging colonists to kill Indigenous people for money. **Surviving New England’s Great Dying** – Just prior to the Pilgrim’s arrival, a plague decimated New England’s coastal Native American population, altering the course of colonialism. The “Great Dying” was caused by an unknown disease that took place between approximately 1616-1619.

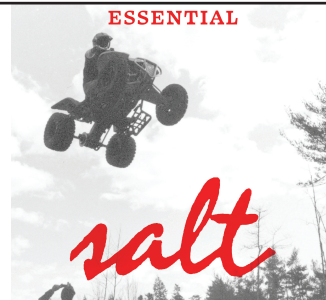


Essential SALT

Maine Jewish Film Festival's 25th Anniversary

The **Maine Jewish Film Festival (MJFF)** will kick off its 25th anniversary on November 4 with a celebration and screening at the Portland Museum of Art, featuring the bittersweet Israeli comedy, *Karaoke*, followed by a party in the Museum's Great Hall. Over the next eight days, the festival will host multiple screenings of over a dozen films from eight countries and four continents in Portland, Bangor, Bethel, Lewiston, Waterville, and Brunswick. 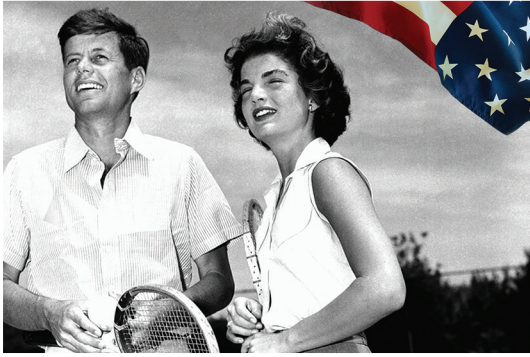
