Summary of Offenses and Probable Cause Affidavit

On 3/15/20, I was dispatched to 714 SW Bond Rd in reference to a domestic incident. Upon arrival I met with the victim/complaint, Joceline Avomo (mom) and was advised of the following:

Joceline's Sunday routine is to attend church. She does not allow her son, Daniel Weisberger (offender) to stay in the house alone. Therefore, she attempted to wake him up to for either church or simply leave the house until her arrival. Daniel "got mad" because he was forced to wake up. A verbal argument then occurred as mom stated he needed to leave the house or accompany her church. Daniel then grabbed her mother by the right wrist pulled then pushed her out of his room as she yelled to leave him alone.

Visible to Joceline's right wrist was redness/swelling as she complained of pain. ST Lucie Rescue #10 was present for aid to her injuries, they did not transport. UCI OFC Paris (317) arrived on scene and captured photos of her injuries.

Next, I spoke with Daniel as he advised to never touching his mother. When questioned on the sequence of events, Daniel stated he was woken up by his mother as she yelled for him to clean his room and go to church. He asked multiple times to leave the room because he was not dressed. At this time Joceline is not fully inside the room, she is between the door. Daniel then pushes the door close. Daniel stated that he cannot advise if the door hit his mother as he attempted to close it.

Based on my investigation at the scene, I determined that probable cause existed to arrest Daniel for one (1) count of simple Battery FSS 784.03. Domestic related as per F.S.S 741.28. Records show that he has had a previous charge of battery; therefore, the charge displays BATTERY-2ND OR SUBSQ OFF, per F.S.S 784.03 (2). Due to the complaint's statement/ injuries probable cause exist. The defendant intentionally touched or struck the victim against his/her will, causing bodily harm to the victim.
