ACTIVITY

MOOD MUSIC

At the end of every day, ask your child to draw a face that expresses how they feel. Together, sing or listen to a song that reflects your child's mood.

GO ON A SIGN SCAVENGER HUNT

Visit a place with lots of signs. Encourage your child to take a picture of each sign they find and discuss what that sign tells us.

GROW A MILK CARTON HERB GARDEN

Fill up an empty milk carton with soil and herbs. Place your herbs in the sun and watch them grow!
TIP: Talk with your child about the importance of water and light to help plants grow.

BLOW BUBBLES IN THE WIND

Blow bubbles in the wind to observe how the wind moves. Have your child draw "wind lines" based on what they learned.

FAMILY TIME

MAKE UP A PINKMAZING DANCE

Encourage your child to turn their favorite animal's movements into a dance. Gather everyone together for a family night and let your child perform their dance.

START A FAMILY SCRAPBOOK

Create and collect images from all of the adventures your family goes on and document them in a family scrapbook.

PLAY SOUP'S UP DIGITAL GAME

Virtually help Elinor choose vegetables from the garden then digitally wash, chop, and cook them in a soup.

GO ON A WEATHER WALK

Take a family walk and use all of your senses to observe the weather outside. **TIP:** Keep a weather log and review it at the end of the month.
