Human Footprint

Human Footprint is a new six-part series that embarks on a journey to understand all the ways humans have transformed the planet. Part science series and part travel show, the series takes viewers from farms to restaurants, from a high-tech lab to a sweltering street market, from pristine rain forests to the sewers of New York City. Stories of science, history, and culture reveal the complicated, conflicted, and remarkable species that is homo sapiens.

The series is not a “doom and gloom” tale of human villainy. Instead, it is an honest reckoning with our vast footprint and our species’ singular history of transforming the planet. As our power to reshape the planet grows, will our understanding of the world we inhabit ever catch up?



On a quest to understand how the world’s top predators (humans) treat other predators on the landscape, the series takes viewers to a sheep ranch in Northern Wyoming. This baby lamb is protected 24/7 from wolves by livestock guardian dogs—an effort by this rancher to try and create a balance with wolves—another predator that we had previously eliminated completely from the landscape.

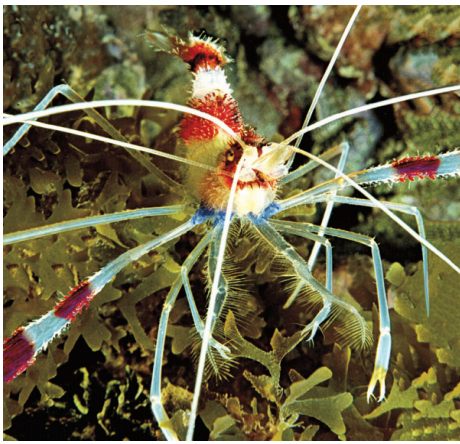

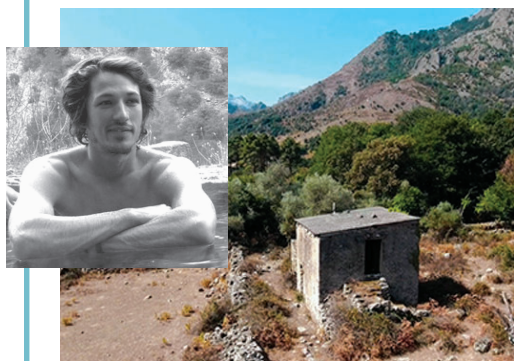

Finding Tyler chronicles the riveting life of promising intellectual turned fugitive, Tyler Johnson. In August of 2003, Tyler Johnson was a prized scholar in theoretical physics. Months later he was homeless on an island off the coast of France, a fugitive wanted by the FBI.

The film follows Tyler's loved ones as they try to piece together the final years of his life as he evaded the FBI on the island of Corsica. For six years Tyler sent letters to his family, each containing cryptic clues about his condition. His final letter was found at his last known whereabouts: a remote mountain refuge near Corsica's highest peaks. Alongside that unsent letter was a journal outlining his years living on the run.

The aspirational words contained within the Declaration helped drive the abolitionist movement, the Women's Suffrage movement, and spurred iconic civil rights figures like

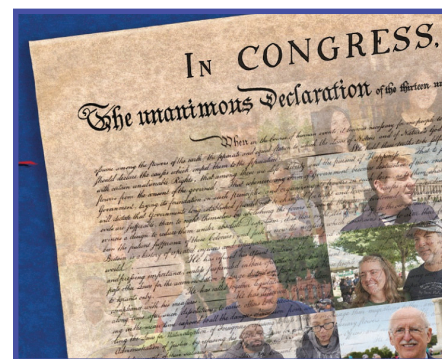
Frederick Douglass and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to action. Internationally, more than 100 countries have created their own Declaration of Independence since 1776.

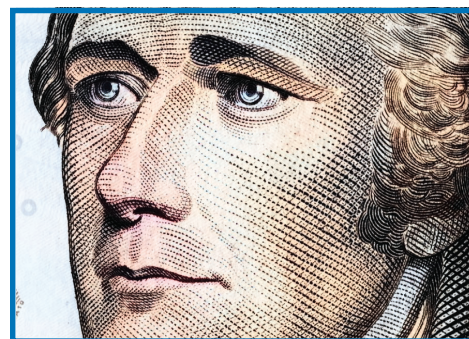
From Wall Street to Bay Street

The 2008 financial crisis rippled across the globe and triggered a worldwide recession. Unlike the American banking system which experienced massive losses, takeovers, and taxpayer funded bailouts, Canada's banking system withstood the crisis relatively well and maintained its liquidity and profitability.

FROM WALL STREET TO BAY STREET examines and compares the financial and banking systems of the United States and Canada, that reflect the political and cultural milieus of two of the world's top ten economies.

The basis for both financial systems was laid by the revolutionary founding father Alexander

Hamilton. While Canada has preserved a Hamiltonian financial tradition, the United States has favored the populist Jacksonian tradition since the 1830s.



The sporadic and inconsistent fashion in which the American system has changed over time is at odds with the evolutionary path taken by the Canadian system.
