On October 12, 2022, *Talk of Iowa* Host Charity Nebbe hosted a one-of-a-kind conversation "Literary Legends: Lan Samantha Chang in Conversation with Charity Nebbe" sponsored by the University of Iowa Lecture Committee. Chang, Director of the Iowa Writers' Workshop and renowned novelist, read from her most recent book, *The Family Chao*.

The University of Iowa's School of Journalism and Mass Communication held a speednetworking event on November 2, 2022. Talk Show Producer Caitlin Troutman participated in the event sharing her expertise and experience with the SJMC students.

Talk of Iowa Host Charity Nebbe hosted the "A Trip I'll Never Forget: A Live Storytelling Event" sponsored by Investigate Midwest in Iowa City on November 3, 2022. The event benefitted "Investigate Midwest" and its "Iowa Watch" newsroom, a non-profit organization created to advance the field of broadcast journalism in the Midwest and in Iowa.

On February 28, 2023, Talk Show Producer Samantha McIntosh and Reporter Zachary Smith hosted a tour of the Iowa City studios for Dr. Sarah Bond's history class at the University of Iowa. *Talk of Iowa* Host Charity Nebbe spoke about her process in preparing for the IPR talk show, "Talk of Iowa". The two fielded questions from Ben and then from the audience at Hancher Auditorium. The program was recorded for rebroadcast the following week on *River to River*.
