The Busing Battleground

On September 12, 1974, police were stationed outside Boston schools as Black and white students were bused for the first time between neighborhoods to comply with a federal court desegregation



order. The cross-town busing met with shocking violence, much of it directed at children. The chaos and racial unrest would continue for years.

"The Busing Battleground" pulls back the curtain on the volatile effort to end school segregation, detailing the decadeslong struggle for educational equity that preceded the crisis.

The Harvest

After the 1954 Supreme Court ruled that racial segregation in public schools was unconstitutional, little more than token efforts were made to desegregate Southern



schools. That changed on October 29, 1969, when the high court ordered Mississippi schools to fully and immediately desegregate.

"The Harvest" follows a coalition of Black and white citizens working to create racially integrated public schools in a southern cotton town steeped in racial intolerance.



Silicon Valley Pain Index

Silicon Valley is known as one of the wealthiest areas of the country, but a large percentage of Silicon Valley's essential workforce and very diverse population has not shared in this prosperity.

Silicon Valley Pain Index tells the story of the challenges these workers face as seen through their efforts to find affordable housing, put food on their tables, and secure a living wage; 28% of Silicon Valley households do not earn enough money to meet the basic needs without assistance. The Silicon Valley Second Harvest Food Bank is providing food for more than a half a million people.

Haymarket: The Bomb, The Anarchists, The Labor Struggle

On May 4th, 1886, a workers' protest rally in Chicago's Haymarket Square turned deadly. An unknown assailant tossed a bomb into a throng of riot police, killing one instantly. In the chaos that erupted, seven policemen were killed, sixty injured, and civilian casualties were likely as high. The event resulted in a trial and execution of presumably innocent workers' rights activists.

Historians and professors examine the history of the bomb and the labor struggle of working people fighting for a shorter workday during the industrial might of Americas Gilded Age.

Truly Texas Mexican

Truly Texas Mexican weaves through Texas cities, reclaiming Native American history. The story of Texas Mexican food begins 15,000 years ago when Native American women domesticated the plants and cooked the same game and fish we eat today.

Over time and during conquest, Texas Mexican food (not tex-mex) sustained Native American memory and identity. Cooking nopalitos, deer, mesquite and tortillas, indigenous women led the cultural resistance against colonization. It's the "comida casera," (home cooking) of today's Texas Mexican American and Native American families.
