Passing the Torch

**A conversation with
WHRO's past and future
development leaders**

In January, WHRO Public Media announced the promotion of Kate Pringle, CFRE, to Vice President of Development following the announcement of Chief Development Officer Tom Burton's upcoming retirement. In her new position, she oversees all areas of development, including membership, major and planned giving, grants, program underwriting, The Voice, volunteer engagement, and front-desk operations.

We recently caught up with Kate to see how she is settling into her new role, and spoke with Tom about his distinguished career and his retirement plans.

Tom, what first drew you to public media, and what kept you here throughout your career?

TOM: After a decade working in for-profit companies, when presented with the opportunity to work for public media whose mission was the public good, and not the bottom line, it was like a lightning strike. There was no going back.

Kate, what drew you to this role and to public media specifically?

KATE: I lived in suburban Pittsburgh for many years as a child, so I grew up watching WQED with *Mister Rogers' Neighborhood* and other fantastic PBS Kids programs. As I got older and planted my roots here in Hampton Roads, I became an NPR nerd. As a long-time sustaining member and fan of WHRO, I often thought how wonderful it would be to work for this organization that I value so deeply. Fundraising can be challenging, but because I wholeheartedly believe in the mission—and benefit from the programs and services every single day—it certainly makes my role both easier and incredibly rewarding.

What has this transition process been like for both of you?

TOM: I am enormously excited at launching into retirement, and I think Kate shares a similar level of excitement at the prospect of playing a very important leadership role in WHRO's future.

KATE: For me, it's been very exciting and very busy! I've worked at WHRO for 6 years, so I have gotten to know our organization, its amazing staff, and so many of our members pretty well over that time. But wearing this new hat, I'm learning so much more from my

development team and how we collaborate with other departments each day.

Kate, what are your top priorities in your first year?

KATE: Connecting with more of our members, particularly those new members or members who increased their support after the loss of federal funding. Showing members the impact of their support. And most importantly, encouraging members to maintain that tremendous support as we look ahead into our new fiscal year and beyond.

How do you see fundraising evolving in today's media landscape?

KATE: As a nonprofit, we are fortunate that we have a very large megaphone with TV and radio when it comes to asking our community for support. But people tune in differently these days, so we have to find different ways to engage and reach people where they are.

Tom, how has the role of fundraising evolved during your tenure?

TOM: Technologies evolve and Administrations come and go. But with no shortage of important brand-new roles for public media, fundraising for non-profit organizations, including WHRO, is more important than it's ever been.

Can you share a moment when you saw firsthand how donor support made a difference?

TOM: A gift to WHRO means so much more than a specific program, a special service, a much-needed educational tool for students and teachers, or a news story.

Instead, that gift, coupled with tens of thousands of other gifts, motivates all residents of Eastern Virginia to rally around their WHRO—donor support does not make a difference. It makes **the** difference.

Kate, what do you think today's donors are really looking for?

KATE: I think donors want to feel connected to and confident in the organizations they support. People want to give to causes they are passionate about and feel personally connected to the mission. They want to see their support is making a real difference and that the organization is being a good steward of their investment.

In a time when trust in media is shifting, why does public media still matter?

KATE: There's a lot of noise out there. I think public media offers clarity. I am constantly learning something new or gaining a better understanding of something, and I appreciate that I can trust that information.

TOM: Trust in media is indeed shifting, with the result that public media matters more right now, than ever before.

Tom, what will you miss most about this work?

TOM: The people. The dedicated, intelligent, creative, talented, and fun people who are WHRO. And WHRO's supporters. All of them. Young and old, rich and poor, those with extensive education, and those without. Community leaders and those who seek to make a difference in other ways. Creative thinkers and news junkies, classical music aficionados, jazz enthusiasts, and bluegrass fans. Those from large families, and those who are all alone. In short, people who care about using non-profit, non-commercial public media to make things better, for everyone.

What's next for you?

TOM: Retirement in Upstate New York with my loving bride, which will allow us to be close to our two daughters, three adorable red-headed grandsons, Jan's dad, and ridiculous amounts of snow.





A COMMUNITY OF CHAMPIONS

WHRO's community responded with extraordinary generosity and conviction when public media faced one of the most significant challenges in the organization's history. Following the sudden elimination of nearly \$2 million in annual federal funding, supporters across Eastern Virginia and Northeastern North Carolina came together to ensure that WHRO could continue its service to the region.

What began as an urgent appeal to WHRO's closest friends and advocates for special contributions above and beyond annual membership support became a powerful demonstration of what public media means to this community. Through the Champions Circle Campaign, donors contributed an incredible \$2.9 million in support of WHRO—far surpassing the original \$2 million goal.

At the heart of the campaign was a transformational leadership commitment from the Hoffmann Charitable Fund, which inspired the community with a \$1 million 1:1 matching gift challenge. Their generosity set the tone for a movement that quickly gained momentum, encouraging supporters from across the region to step forward and invest in the future of trusted journalism, educational programming, storytelling, music, culture, and lifelong learning.

The campaign was launched in response to a stark reality: the complete loss of federal funding that had long helped sustain WHRO's mission and community service. Yet even amid uncertainty, supporters understood what was at stake. They recognized the

transformative power of public media and the enduring impact WHRO has throughout the communities it serves.

Every contribution—large and small—played a meaningful role in the campaign's success. Each donor became a champion for public media, helping ensure that WHRO remains a trusted, independent resource during a time when access to factual information, educational content, and meaningful local connection is more important than ever.

The campaign also reinforced something deeply powerful: WHRO is not just a media organization. It is a community institution strengthened by people who believe in the value of informed citizens, inspired learners, and connected communities.

The success of the Champions Circle Campaign stands as a testament to the vision, generosity, and unwavering commitment of WHRO supporters. Because of them, WHRO moves forward with strength, optimism, and renewed confidence in the community it serves.

To every donor of the Champions Circle Campaign and to all of the members who generously increased your annual membership support or sustaining gift, WHRO offers its deepest gratitude. Each and every supporter proved to be a true champion of public media.
