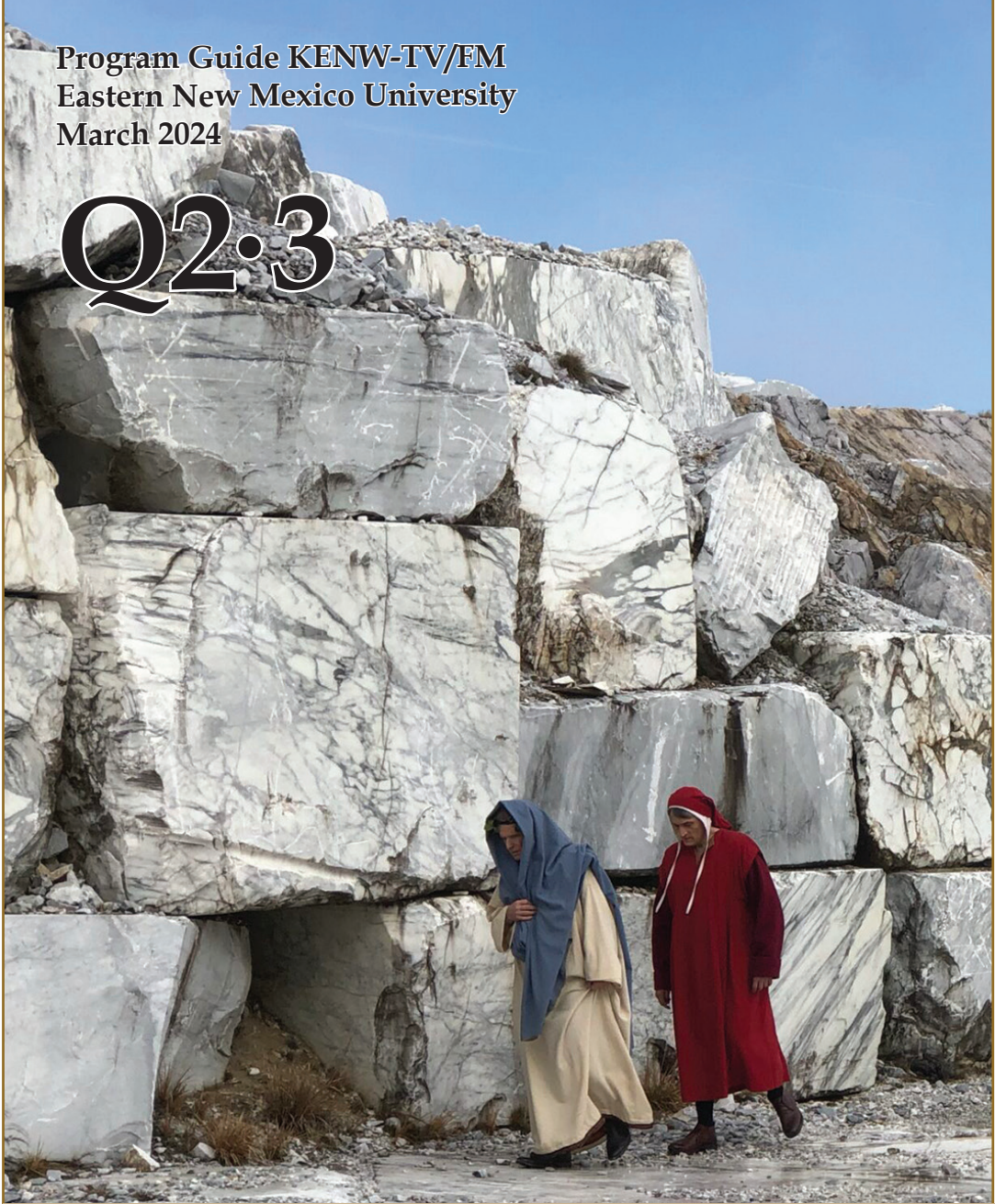

Bonomassa's nonprofit Keeping the Blues Alive has reached 74,000 students and aims at supporting music in schools as well as helping musicians in need.

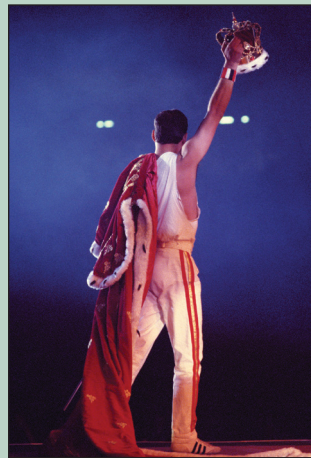
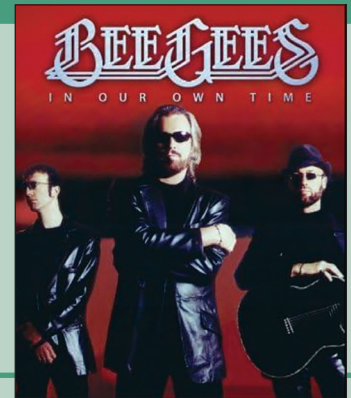

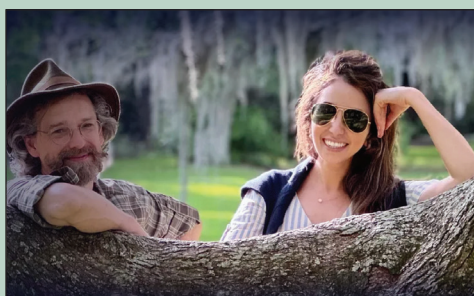

FACING THE LAUGHTER: MINNIE PEARL

Small-town girl Sarah Cannon dreamed of becoming a Shakespearean actress; instead, she became famous as the class-act comedian Minnie Pearl. With her "How-dee" greeting and price tag dangling from her straw hat, this simple character became an icon of country music through radio, live stage performances, and television.

The educated, serious Cannon and her playful, uncomplicated alter ego created a legacy of compassion, empowerment and humor. This 90-minute documentary **Facing the Laughter: Minnie Pearl** explores how this beloved character impacted American culture and how it's still relevant today.

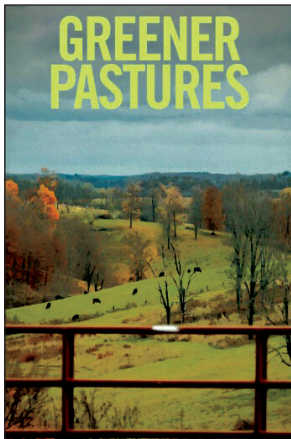

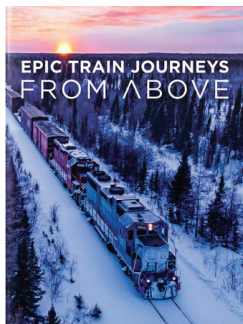
