6) Supplemental Recruitment Initiatives.

a) Initiative: Internship Program

Internship Program with Baylor University

- i) A female Public Relations major from Baylor University interned at KWBU during the spring 2022 semester (January 2022 May 2022). The student worked approximately 10 hours per week under the supervision of the KWBU President & CEO. Her ongoing assignment was to assist with KWBU's weekly e-newsletter, provide regular updates to KWBU's social media (Facebook and Instagram), and monitor user engagement with the station's social media accounts. For this job she would select relevant local, regional, and national stories from the previous week, write brief summary paragraphs, create graphics and select appropriate photos or art. The newsletter was (and is) distributed every Friday morning to KWBU's list of supporters. KWBU's social media accounts are updated at least three times per day.
- ii) Another female Public Relations major from Baylor University worked with KWBU during the fall 2022 semester (September 2022 December 2022). She spent approximately 10 hours per week at the station, working with the KWBU President & CEO. Her main job duty was to assist in editing KWBU's weekly e-newsletter. She would select relevant local, regional, and national stories from the previous week; write a brief summary; and select appropriate photos or art to illustrate the stories. She assembled the newsletter to be distributed every Friday morning to KWBU's list of supporters. In addition, she created graphic station and program promotions for both the web and print and tracked KWBU's social media accounts (Facebook and Instagram), selecting and posting timely news stories from NPR and KWBU local productions, and tracking audience engagement.
- iii) KWBU hosted one male Film and Digital Media major from Baylor University as a production/operations intern during the fall semester of 2022 (September 2022 December 2022) and again during the spring semester of 2023 (January 2023 May 2023). He is working under the supervision of the KWBU Station Manager and his duties include recording, editing and posting on-air promos, voicing some promos, and participating in KWBU's on-air fund drives.

b) Initiative: Participation in Programs Sponsored by an Educational Institution

- i) On March 30, 2022, the KWBU President & CEO met with a group of five Baylor University Journalism students regarding their Public Relations Communications class project. He outlined the mission of KWBU and what KWBU provides to the Central Texas community and how the work is divided at the station. He described the different responsibilities of each area of the station on-air, membership, corporate support, and administrative responsibilities. Additionally, a member/supporter of the station joined in the discussion and explained how important the service is to the community from a listener's perspective.
- ii) Through a new partnership with the Baylor University Department of Journalism, Public Relations and New Media, students in a broadcast reporting and writing class will be submitting original reports for possible broadcast during the spring 2023 semester. Approximately fifteen students from this class visited KWBU on February 9, 2023, to tour the station and learn more about public radio in preparation for their reporting assignments.
- c) Initiative: Provision of training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination
 - In Summer 2022, all KWBU staff completed the 2022 Preventing Harassment and Discrimination online training course provided through the Corporation for Public Broadcasting concerning harassment prevention.
 - ii) On October 6, 2022, KWBU Business Affairs Manager completed Baylor University's on-line training course "Courageous Conversations: Belonging."
 - iii) On January 12, 2023, KWBU Business Affairs Manager completed Baylor University's on-line Get Inclusive training course "Meridians: Title IX Course."
