Summary of Offenses and Probable Cause Affidavit

On 8/15/2022, The offender Marques Jones did the commit the following offenses in violation of F.S.S. 893.13, Possession of Cocaine, F.S.S. 790.23, Possession of a weapon and/or ammo by a convicted felon, F.S.S. 784.07, Aggravated Assault on Law Enforcement (2 counts), and F.S.S. 843.02, Resisting arrest without violence.

On 8/15/2022, members of the Warrants Unit/ US Marshals Fugitive Task Force conducted an operational briefing in reference to newly obtained felony arrest warrants for Marques Jones, which was created from an incident which occurred in the jurisdiction of the Port Saint Lucie Police Department. It was stated during the briefing Jones was heard saying he will not go back to prison and he will shoot any "cop" that tries to arrest him. It was also discussed Jones is documented as a registered career offender with an extensive violent criminal history. It was reported to the warrants unit Jones was possibly in possession of handgun.

Warrants units were attempting to serve a felony arrest warrant on Jones at 3008 Avenue R, in the City of Fort Pierce, Florida, when Jones armed himself with a handgun and fled the residence. During the course of Jones fleeing, Jones pointed his weapon at Victim two (V2). As he continued to flee, he also pointed his weapon in the vicinity of Victim one (V1). During a pat down search for contraband at the time of his arrest, Jones was found to be in possession of a white powdery substance, which field-tested positive for cocaine.

During interviews with the involved Warrants Unit and Task Force Detectives, V1 advised he was in the area to conduct a

Felony warrant arrest on Jones. V1 stated he observed Jones running from the address listed above. As Jones was running, V1 observed Jones was carrying a handgun in his right hand. Upon stopping his agency issued unmarked St Lucie County Sheriff's Office vehicle, V1 gave orders for Jones to stop and drop the gun. V1 stated fearing for his personal safety and the safety of other converging Detectives, along with the public; he fired his agency issued service weapon towards the armed and fleeing Jones. Jones immediately fell to the ground, discarding his weapon as he did so, and laid prone on the ground, with his arms out and up. The Detectives were able to approach Jones, securing the handgun and him. V1 states Jones was placed into hand restraints at this point. Jones advised the on scene Detectives he was a coward and had planned to have the pursuing Detectives shoot him.

During the interview with V2, he advised he was tasked with locating, surveilling, and apprehending Jones. He along with several other Detectives located and positively identified Jones in front of the residence located at 3008 Avenue R. V2 advised he pulled his agency issued unmarked vehicle up towards the residence. As V2 did this, he observed Jones immediately walk to a grey/silver Mercedes vehicle, which was backed into the driveway of the residence. Jones reached down into the area of the front passenger seat. V2 stated Jones emerged from the vehicle with a handgun in his right hand. V2 stated Jones immediately pointed the firearm at him. V2 stated fearing his safety as well as other converging Detectives, along with the general public, he pointed his agency issued long rifle at Jones. Jones then immediately turned away and fled toward the west. V2 did not discharge his weapon and began a foot pursuit of Jones.

Jones was transport to the Sheriff's Office Detective Bureau for a formal interview. The interview was audio and video recorded. After being read his Miranda warning from an agency issued card, Jones stated he understood his rights and agreed to speak with me without an attorney present.



Jones was arrested on the active felony warrants from the prior incident, which occurred in Port St. Lucie (PSLPD case #2022-19122).

A Law Enforcement Baker Act form was completed and delivered to the jail for service later.

Jones was transported to the St. Lucie County Jail for processing.

There is no further information available at this time.
