JUDGMENT

Now on this 22nd day of July, 2016 this cause was called. Petitioner appears by the undersigned Assistant Circuit Attorney. Mack Donald Taylor, though served and more than 30 days having elapsed from the date of service, appears not, and is in default as to his pleadings. The Court, having reviewed the pleadings of the parties, the Affidavit in Support of Default Judgment, the required Form 14 with earning information from the Missouri Division of Employment Security, and Affidavit of State Debt takes the matter as submitted. It is ordered, adjudged and decreed that

1. Bernadine Shipp is the mother and Mack Donald Taylor is the father of Malik D. Taylor, born [REDACTED]

2. Mack Donald Taylor was served in Missouri with process in this cause.
3. Said child is residing with Tonia Marcetta Shipp.
4. Mack Donald Taylor has the capacity to support said child.
5. Mack Donald Taylor was served with process in this cause on January 8, 2016.
6. Mack Donald Taylor first entered his appearance in this cause on March 4, 2016.
7. The Bureau of Vital Records of the Department of Health of the State of Missouri is hereby ordered to amend the birth certificate of Malik D. Taylor, born March 28, 1999 to name Mack Donald Taylor as the father of Malik D. Taylor, born March 28, 1999.

8. The Petitioners, as their interests may lie, shall have and recover from Mack Donald Taylor the sum of \$ 99.00 monthly as and for the support of said minor child, commencing on ~~February 1, 2016~~ August 1, 2016, and, unless otherwise terminated by the provisions of Section 452.340 RSMo, said child support payments shall continue thereafter until further order of Court or by operation of law.

9. Commencing on ~~February 1, 2016~~ August 1, 2016, with the first payment due on ~~February 1, 2016~~ August 1, 2016, Mack Donald Taylor shall pay all such sums by cash, money order or cashier's check to the Family Support Payment Center, P.O. Box 109002, Jefferson City, Missouri 65110-9002, as Trustee for Petitioners as their interest may lie.

10. Mack Donald Taylor shall provide medical, dental and hospitalization insurance for said minor child.

11. Mack Donald Taylor shall henceforth pay one half of all of said child's medical, dental and hospitalization expenses incurred that are not covered by insurance.

12. Mack Donald Taylor shall pay the cost of this proceeding.

13. Mack Donald Taylor shall pay to the Missouri Family Support Division \$35.00 for service of process and \$144.00 for genetic tests taken in this matter.



14. An assignment of Mack Donald Taylor's wages or other income from his employer or employers shall be ordered to take effect immediately, and Mack Donald Taylor's wages or other income shall be subject to withholding without further notice. Said assignment to be an amount which is sufficient to meet the periodic child support payments and any additional payments ordered under this judgment. Further, that said assignment shall include an additional amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of one month's current support obligation to defray any delinquent payments owed at the time the assignment takes effect until the delinquency is fully paid.

15. All other claims and parties are hereby dismissed without prejudice.




