WHRO Federal Funding Update

Kelsey provided an update on the status of WHRO's federal funding. She directed members to the **WHRO Champions webpage** and encouraged them to use the talking points provided by Bert in recent emails. She also thanked the many CAB members who have already contacted their representatives.

News Event Committee Update

Rowena provided an overview of the newly formed **News Event Committee** and asked members to share venue suggestions with Kelsey.

The event will be an informal, interactive panel hosted by **Maurice Jones**, focused on the importance of local journalism and building trust with the community. The event is planned for October and will serve as a space to:

- Showcase WHRO's commitment to transparent, trustworthy journalism
- Humanize WHRO reporters as neighbors and members of the community
- Explain how a story moves from tip to publication
- Provide an opportunity for the public to engage directly with WHRO's newsroom staff

Denise suggested incorporating an interactive activity, such as a poster or display asking attendees questions like, "Where do you get your news?" or "What makes you trust a news source?"

WHRO Updates

- **Another View:** Barbara Hamm Lee shared the history and impact of her radio program *Another View*, followed by Q&A from the CAB.
- **Newsroom Growth:** Maurice Jones provided an update on WHRO's newsroom expansion and staffing efforts before having to step out.
- **Data Reporting:** Kelsey introduced WHRO's new data reporter and shared his first article to help CAB members understand his role in producing community-focused journalism.
- Virginia Humanities at WHRO Grant:
 - o The inaugural grant cycle is complete; 11 nonprofit organizations were selected as awardees from 35 applicants.
 - The Advisory Board that reviewed applications was composed of community leaders, not WHRO or Virginia Humanities staff or board members.
 - o A celebratory event will be held at WHRO on **July 24, 2025** to honor the grant recipients, an invitation will follow.
 - Kelsey thanked the CAB for their outreach efforts and gave special recognition to volunteer Rich
 H. for his support.
- WHRO+ App: Kelsey provided a live demonstration of the new WHRO+ app, now available on Roku and Apple TV.
- Curate Update: Kelsey shared an update on *Curate*, WHRO's local arts series.
