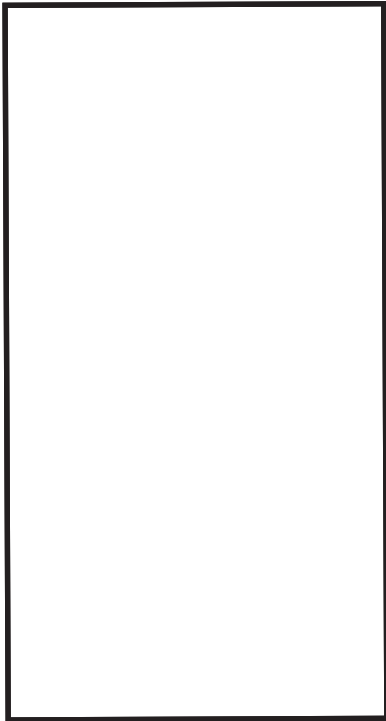

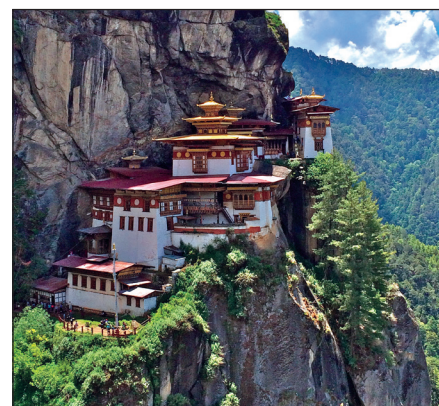

## Himalaya Connection

Shot in seven countries, this film explores the far-reaching effects of the Indian and Eurasian tectonic plates crashing below the Himalayas. It reveals how the plate collision created notable geological superlatives: Earth's highest mountain range—the Himalayas—and some of Earth's largest rivers, such as the Ganges and Indus, which sustain 45 percent of all the people in the world. Yet these rich benefits to humanity are coupled with great risks in the form of major earthquakes, flooding, and erosion. In the wake of the devastating Nepal earthquake of 2015, scientists race against nature's clock, after uncovering a vast hidden fault potentially affecting the lives of 140 million people.

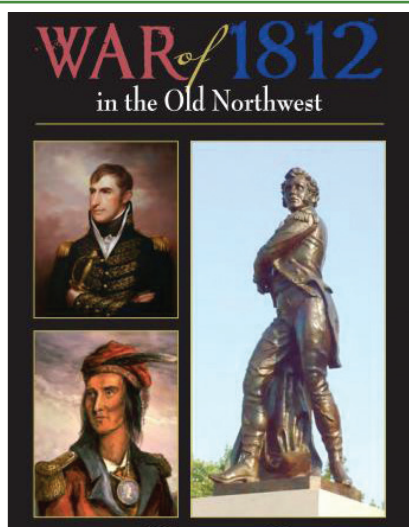

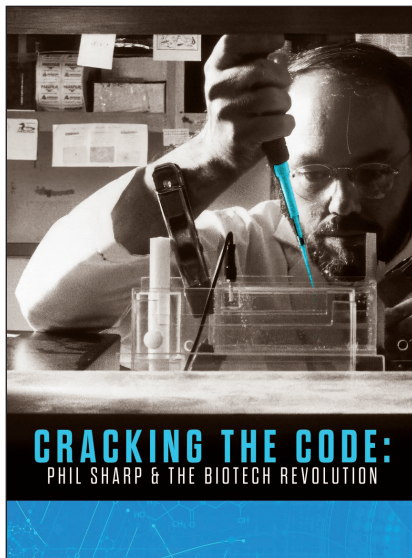

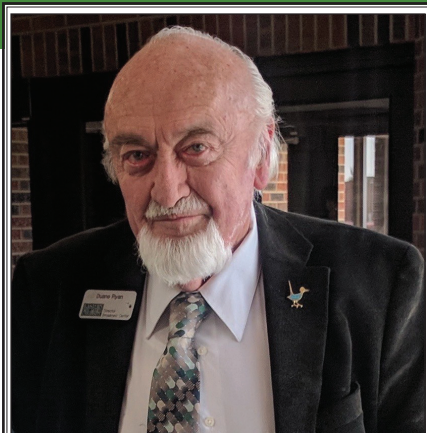
