

THE CLEVELAND ORCHESTRA ON THE RADIO

Sundays at 4 p.m.

Sunday afternoons on WCLV have been the place to hear previously recorded concerts by The Cleveland Orchestra, and there are four concerts in October you won't want to miss.

On October 5, Leila Josefowicz is the soloist in Alban Berg's moving Violin Concerto, and the program also features Mozart's Serenade No. 10 in B-flat for winds. Guest conductor Elim Chan [pictured] leads music by Rachmaninoff, including the Piano Concerto No. 3 with Yefim Bronfman as soloist, on October 12. Esa-Pekka Salonen is on the podium for Ravel and Sibelius, as well as his own Cello Concerto, airing on October 19. Finally, on October 26, Sanntu-Mathias Rouvali leads works by Nielsen, Tchaikovsky and Sibelius.

Music Director Laureate of The Cleveland Orchestra, Christoph von Dohnányi [pictured], died on September 6, just two days shy of his 96th birthday. Join us for a look at some of the lesser-known repertoire championed by Dohnányi, who from his earliest days as a conductor was a strong advocate for new music. Join longtime WCLV host and producer Mark Satola on an hour-long tour of music by such giants of modern music as Witold Lutoslawski, Edgard Varèse, Charles Ives. and Alfred Schnittke.




