(i) Job Fair Participation – In two years' time: Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions	KSUI FM, WSUI AM participated in the Fall 2019 Jump-Start Internship and Networking Fair hosted by the Iowa State University Greenlee School of Journalism and Communication on October 1, 2019. Participation in the Fair allowed the organization to present internship and professional employment opportunities in public radio to students. Participation also provided the opportunity to raise awareness of the organization. KSUI FM, WSUI AM participated in the Spring 2020 Jump-Start Internship and Networking Fair hosted by the Iowa State University Greenlee School of Journalism and Communication on Mach 5, 2020. Participation in the Fair allowed the organization to present internship and professional employment opportunities in public radio to students. Participation also provided the opportunity to raise awareness of the organization.
(iv) Participation in community group events – In two years' time: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops, and similar activities	Talk of lowa Host Charity Nebbe moderated a panel discussion on "Characteristics of Effective Neighborhoods" at an Iowa Ideas forum, an event organized by The Gazette in Cedar Rapids, Iowa on October 3, 2019. The panel discussed building effective neighborhoods and was recorded and produced to air on Talk of Iowa. River to River Host Ben Kieffer moderated "The Burden of Gun Violence: Trends and Policy Solutions" on October 23, 2019. This non-partisan event, sponsored by the University of Iowa Public Policy Center, hosted a panel of national experts to discuss data related to the burden of American gun violence and the potential for evidence-based public policy solutions.

(iv) Participation in community group events – (Cont'd)	River to River Host Ben Kieffer moderated a Pecha Kucha event hosted by the University of Iowa's College of Public Health on February 27, 2020. The event engaged the community in a conversation about public health and current events and showcased College of Public Heath faculty and community presenters. Talk Show Producer Katelyn Harrop participated in a panel discussion at the University of Iowa's "Communicating Ideas" workshop on July 10, 2020. The panelists spoke to University
	of lowa faculty on how best to talk about their work with the media.
(v) Internship Program – In two years' time: Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment	KSUI FM, WSUI AM continued its internship program offering opportunities to students involving digital, news and talk show production. The internship program works primarily with students at the University of Iowa, offering hands-on, skills-developing internships that prepare students for employment after graduation. Several students who have participated in the program have later enjoyed successful careers in public media. To highlight one internship from this past year, in the Talk Show department, three students assisted the producers of the daily talk shows by researching and booking guests, conducting pre-interviews, screening calls during call-in portions of the shows, and posting the show audio and supporting text on the website.
(viii) Training Programs – In two years' time: Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions	KSUI FM, WSUI AM encourages participation in career-development opportunities which includes webinars, in-person training and attending conferences. In the ever-changing public media environment, participation in such programs allows employees to increase their knowledge in areas relevant to their work. A few of those programs are outlined as examples of how KSUI FM, WSUI AM supports training opportunities for its staff. News/Talk Program Director Katherine Perkins participated in NPR's "Spring 2019 Broadcast Ratings" webinar on October 30, 2019. Talk Show Producer Katelyn Harrop attended the annual Legislative Forum hosted by The Associated Press in Des Moines on January 7, 2020.

(viii) Training Programs (Cont'd) -

River to River Host Ben Kieffer and Talk Show Producer Katelyn Harrop participated in SciLine's "SciLine & ASA Media Briefing: Covering Opinion Polls and Surveys" on June 17, 2020. The online workshop focused on understanding polling data.

News/Talk Program Director Katherine Perkins participated in Radio Research Consortium's "Audience Insights on COVID-19: The First Six Months of 2020 PPM Data" on July 22, 2020. Dave Sullivan of RRC, with special guest Scott Williams, led the webinar providing analysis and discussion on changes in radio listening during the all-encompassing pandemic of 2020.

News/Talk Program Director Katherine Perkins participated in NPR's "On Air Best Practices" webinar on September 2, 2020.
