

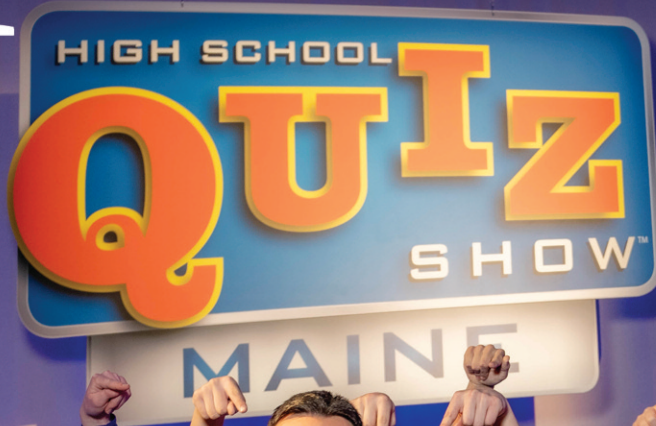

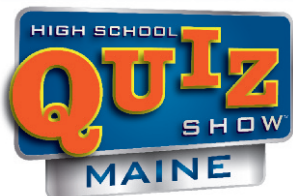

IT'S BACK! **High School Quiz Show Maine** hits the airwaves on Thursday, March 21, with an exciting line-up of participating schools and challenging questions.

Each episode of **High School Quiz Show Maine** premieres on Maine Public Television on Thursdays starting at 8:00 p.m. and are rebroadcast on Fridays starting at 2:00 p.m. and Sundays at 5:00 p.m. Once aired, each episode is available at mainepublic.org every Thursday evening.

High School Quiz Show Maine is a locally produced television production spearheaded by veteran producer Nick Woodward pitting four-student teams from Maine high schools against each other in a single-elimination, academic bracket competition.

Questions used in each contest align with the Maine high school curriculum standards across literature, history, science and math as well as including questions regarding current events and general knowledge. Each episode will feature video questions from notable civic and business leaders in Maine as well as a "Viewer Question of the Week" that our at-home viewers can try to answer. Todd Gutner, the Chief Meteorologist at News Center Maine, once again takes the reins as the host.

The winning team will receive a \$1,000 gift to their school's Project Graduation with the runner-up being awarded a \$500 gift. Every participant this season is treated to a gift certificate, compliments of Aroma Joe's.

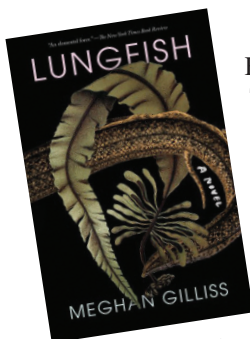

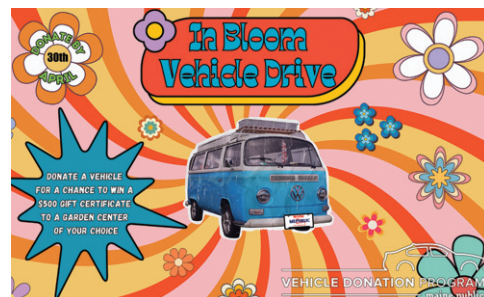

Maine Public was awarded construction permits for seven new FM radio signals in Maine – four of the signals specifically slated for classical programming! These potential new signals could extend news, cultural content, and the emergency alert service to underserved parts of northern Maine and into maritime Canada, reaching an additional 71,000 full-time Maine residents. Maine Public is fundraising for this initiative to secure the necessary resources to build new towers and secure the right equipment.
