Love Again." Between songs, Bacharach shares the stories behind some of his best-loved hits.

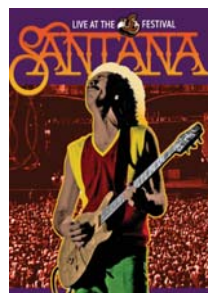

This visually stunning film highlights the culture, use and history of New Mexico's enduring acequias (gravity-fed ditches).

The estimated 700 to 800 surviving acequias are the lifeblood of northern New Mexico, carrying mountain snowmelt and rain to fields, orchards and gardens for more than 400 years.

These small earthen waterways evolved over thousands of years in the Middle East. They spread to Spain during the eighth century and when the Spanish arrived in the Southwest, they used these irrigation techniques.
