Two college students were selected this year: Student 1 start: 09/11/2024; end: 07/31/2025. Student 2, start 02/07/2025 end: 09/01/2025. They worked closely with programming and technical staff to enhance their education in journalism and broadcasting.2. WUNC's Digital News Department began an internship program during the spring semester, which will continue into the fall. One college student was selected this year (1/28/2025 – 7/31/2025), who worked closely with programming and technical staff to enhance her education in journalism and broadcasting.3. WUNC's daily program, "Due South," began an internship program during the spring semester, which will continue into the fall. One college student was selected this year (2/18/2025 - 5/24/2025), who worked closely with programming and technical staff to enhance her education in journalism and broadcasting.4.
