Turn: Washington's Spies

10-part series begins Sunday, August 24, at 6:55 pm

ARAMA SET DURING THE Revolutionary War takes viewers behind the battlefront to a covert struggle fought by everyday heroes.

At the start of the Revolutionary War, insurgents and loyalists engaged in a shadow war, where friends and neighbors were forced to choose sides and keep their heroics a secret. This clandestine world of espionage unfolds in the character-driven drama series **Turn:** Washington's Spies.

The program is based on Alexander Rose's book "Washington's Spies: The Story of America's First Spy Ring." It revolves around Abe Woodhull (Jamie Bell), a young farmer torn between loyalty to his Tory background and respect for those who fight for the patriot cause. Living on British-occupied Long Island, Abe joins a group of his childhood friends to form what becomes known as the Culper Ring, a spy network charged with sniffing out British military strategy.

The daring efforts of the rebels revolutionized the art of espionage, giving birth to modern methods as we know it today, along with all the moral complexity

that entails. Together, they risked their lives and honor, and turned against family and king, for a fight they believed in passionately, ultimately helping George Washington turn the tide of the Revolutionary War in favor of the rebels.

Program Notes...

Our delightful Maine summer continues as we move into August, and despite the slower, Vacationland pace of life, Maine Public is here to offer a treasure trove of programming for you to enjoy in your down time.

We have just launched our **Essential Salt** podcast, a collection of richly reported stories about living and working in Maine – a state that is a microcosm of the most pressing challenges facing the U.S. From tensions between rural and urban values, to how we make sense

of the past in a way that builds toward a strong future, stories about Maine have a lot to teach us about what it means to belong to a place and a community. **Essential Salt** is available where you get your podcasts and at mainepublic.org.

On television, our **Maine Public Film Series** brings us **Voices From the Barrens: Native People, Blueberries and Sovereignty**, on Thursday evening, August 7th. The film captures the wild blueberry harvest of the Wabanaki People from the U.S. and Canada as the tribes are challenged to balance blueberry hand raking traditions with the economics of the world market. And on Tuesday, August 12th, the series brings us **Vanish – Disappearing Icons of a Rural America**. This picturesque documentary follows photographer Jim Westphalen as he captures striking images of America's past, rural structures that are quickly disappearing. Also on August 12th, we'll see a special preview of **The American Revolution**, an epic new film from Ken Burns, Sarah Botstein and David Schmidt, that explores the country's founding struggle and its eight-year War for Independence. The complete six-part, 12-hour series will premiere in November, a cornerstone in our **America 250** commemoration.

This year also marks the 250th anniversary of Jane Austen's birth, and we are excited to celebrate this milestone with encore presentations of some of the most renowned BBC adaptations of Austen's works. Our celebration gets underway on Sunday evening, August 10th, with **Pride & Prejudice**, the epic six-hour series featuring Colin Firth and Jennifer Ehle. Later in the fall, we'll bring you two more Austen classics from the BBC: **Emma** and **Sense & Sensibility**.





Go see MSMT's West Side Story

Maine Public is pleased to be a media sponsor of Maine State Music Theatre's production of *West Side Story*. The play is a timeless musical about two young lovers, Tony and Maria, who are caught in the crossfire of a violent gang rivalry in New York City. 


