OUTREACH INITIATIVES for 9/22/22 – 9/21/23

WMFE/WMFV has successfully initiated and completed the following outreach initiatives during this reporting period:

INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

The Orlando area has a wealth of students to draw from for our internship program – UCF, Full Sail University, Florida Institute of Technology and various community colleges and high schools. Interns have provided a stable source for assistance to WMFE/WMFV news staff. This year WMFE/WMFV utilized three interns in the Radio News Department. Two students were from UCF and one was from FIT this fiscal year. The breakdown by half year is as follows: 1 from the 1st half of the year (Oct 2022 – Mar 2023) and 2 from the 2nd half of the year (Apr – Sept 2023).

PROVIDING TRAINING TO MANAGEMENT LEVEL PERSONNEL AS TO METHODS OF ENSURING EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY AND PREVENTING DISCRIMINATION

All employees, completed the Preventing Harassment and Discrimination training provided by the CPB (training was released in May 2023 to be completed no later than Sep 2023).

The Director of Finance and Administration participated in training webinars presented by NAB, Withum, PMBA, EAF, and other sources covering the following topics designed to ensure equal employment and prevent discrimination:

- Giving the Gift of Community Hope (Feb 2023)
- HR Roundtable Discussion (Apr 2023)
- Advancing DEI through Multi-Station Collaboration (May 2023)
- Viewing your employees as Humans, not Workers (Jun 2023)
- A holistic approach to addressing DEI issues (Aug 2023)

All staff participated in two DEIB training sessions:

- DEIB General Workshop (Jun 2023)
- Bias and Microaggression (Sept 2023)

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Throughout plan year 2022 – 2023, WMFE/WMFV provided voice training mentoring to news staff.

In March 2023, WMFE/WMFV participated in the Current Public Media Virtual Job Fair, which was held online with video interview "rooms" that allowed the station to talk to candidates about specific open positions but also to allow opportunities to others that had different diverse backgrounds and talk about potential careers in public media.

In June 2023, the President and GM participated in an event "Celebrating Freedom and Advancing DEI in Orlando" sponsored by the Orlando Economic Partnership.
