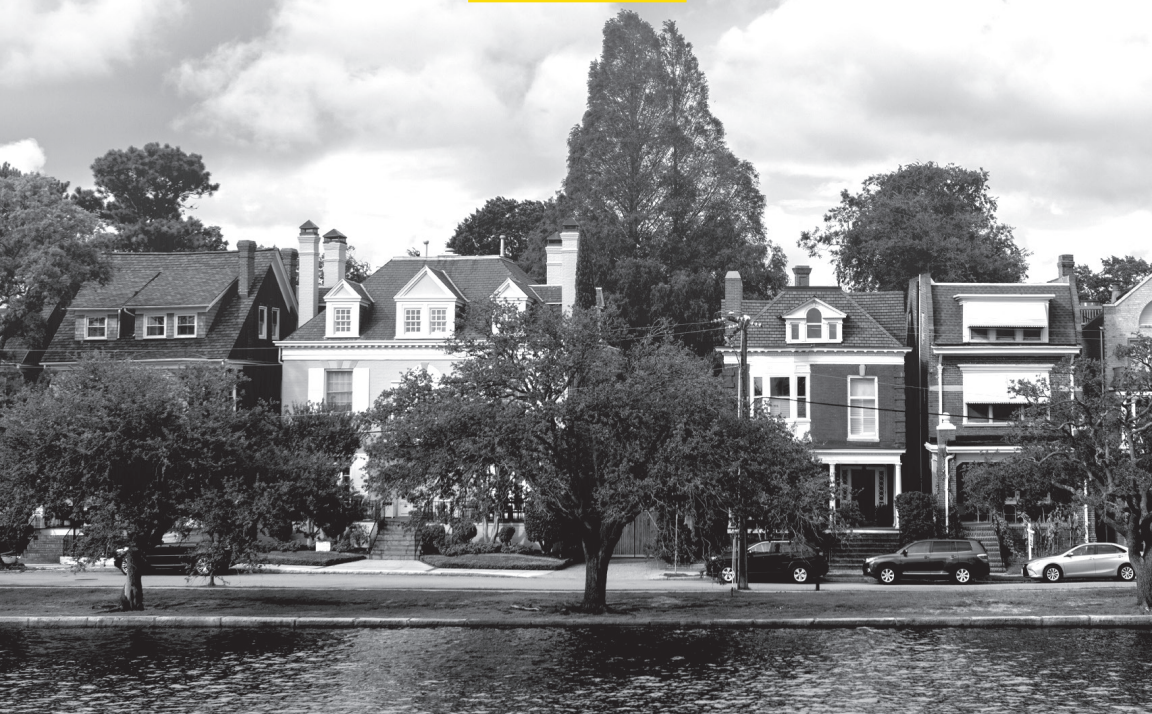

REVOLUTION REVISITED AMERICA AT 250

In celebration of America's 250th anniversary, WHRO Public Media is proud to launch a project that uncovers and shares often overlooked local stories of Revolutionary War contributions. This special series will spotlight the pivotal roles played by individuals from all walks of life, including women, Indigenous peoples, African Americans, and others whose efforts helped shape both the revolutionary cause and the nation's history.

WHRO's service area, which includes historically significant cities such as Yorktown, Jamestown, Williamsburg, Hampton, Newport News, Norfolk, and Portsmouth, was central to the Revolutionary War, with crucial battles taking place both on land and in the harbor. In partnership with the American Revolution Museum in Yorktown, WHRO will conduct extensive research to bring these untold stories to light.

The project will feature a multimedia series of video vignettes that will be

broadcast, streamed across digital platforms, and made available to educators statewide through WHRO's eMediaVA platform. In addition to video content, WHRO producers are creating a weekly podcast series, *Revolution Revisited: America at 250*, that begins July 7 and will be broadcast Mondays on WHRV and WHRO and be available on all podcast platforms. The 52-episode series will highlight local Revolutionary War events, notable historical figures, lesser-known regional stories and lore, and more.

WHRO will also host two live remote radio broadcasts of its weekly program *Another View*—one from Fort Monroe, and the other from the American Revolution Museum in Yorktown.

In addition, WHRO will host and produce a live panel discussion series called *History Unscripted*—where local historians, authors, and community leaders discuss current events through a historical lens, particularly relating to themes of



democracy, freedom, and identity as explored in Virginia's past and present. This quarterly series will be broadcast live on WHRV 89.5, and will take audience questions through social platforms and live calls where listeners can engage directly with the panel. Programs will be recorded and available on demand for download and streaming after the broadcast.

In the fall, WHRO will host an exclusive sneak peek screening of acclaimed filmmaker Ken Burns' highly anticipated documentary *The American Revolution* —on the Yorktown Battlefield! The event will include an appearance by filmmaker David Schmidt, a Williamsburg native and former Fife and Drum Corps member. This free community event aims to foster reflection, discussion, and a deeper appreciation of our nation's rich history. Mark your calendar for Saturday, September 20, so you don't miss it!

Families can also enjoy engaging activities and live music before the screening, which

are made possible through partnerships with York County, the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation, and other local organizations and park partners. The screening is free and open to the public; advanced registration is required. Visitors are encouraged to bring lawn chairs and water, and to prepare for the weather.

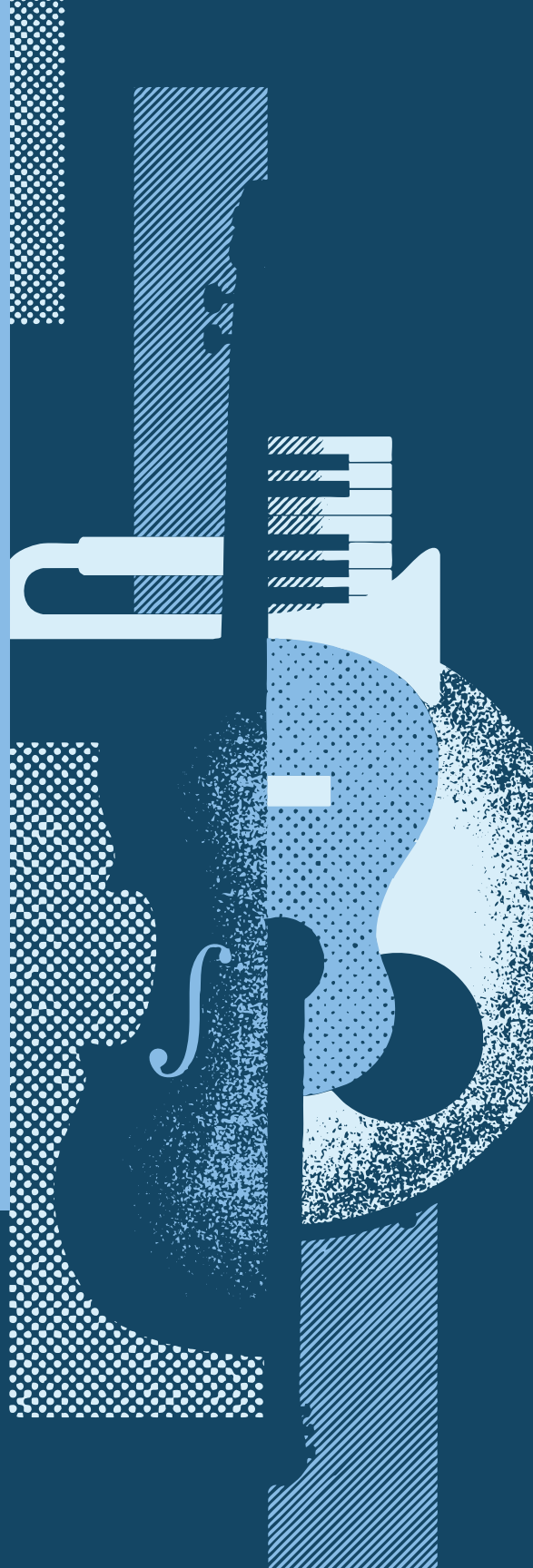

LEGACY IN TUNE: A CLASSICAL MUSIC LOVER'S GIFT TO THE FUTURE

For Thaddeus “Ted” Bednarski, classical music has always been more than just a pastime—it has been a lifelong companion, a source of solace, and a guiding presence throughout his life.

As a young boy growing up in a small Illinois farming town in the 1950s, Ted often heard the sounds of classical music drifting through his open bedroom windows. Just two blocks away was the community band shell, and the music played there would make its way to Ted, comforting him as he drifted off to sleep.

That source of comfort stayed with him. When he joined the military in the late 1970s and was stationed both stateside and abroad, classical music remained a consistent companion. From his time in noisy dormitories to the stressors of military service and the ups and downs of life, Ted turned to his portable cassette player or the local classical music radio station for relief.

After twenty years of military service, Ted became a police officer. Time in his patrol car brought the noise of the streets, voices from his police radio, and constant calls on his phone—all offset by the moving music from his radio. His dial was set to 90.3 FM, and the melodious voice of Dwight Davis kept him even-keeled during long twelve-hour shifts. Ted shared, “On more than one occasion while transporting a ‘misguided’ person

to lockup, I would find my passenger mellowed out or asleep in the back seat.”

From those childhood moments of hearing music from the community center to his years in the military and law enforcement, Ted found constant joy and comfort in classical music. And through much of that time, his radio was tuned to WHRO FM 90.3. Now, “with more miles in the rearview mirror than over the hood of the vehicle,” Ted has chosen to include WHRO-FM as a beneficiary in his will.

With this generous gift, Ted will ensure that future generations experience the same magic. His support will help keep WHRO-FM’s broadcasts strong and accessible, benefiting a community of listeners who, like him, find comfort and connection in every note.
