2/5: In the Bubble with laime. In South Carolina, African American candidate laime Harrison faces incumbent Lindsev Graham for U.S. Senate, As COVID-19 disrupts, Harrison confronts not only the pandemic but deep-rooted racial prejudice. But, in a state with a significant African American population, his campaign against Graham becomes a symbol of hope in a time of crisis, intertwining politics, and race and health challenges.

From disparities in housing, education and healthcare to economic inequality, Firsthand: Segregation illustrates the high cost of division, not just in dollars, but in lives lost and unrealized potential. RECIPE OF THE MONTH

GRILLED CORN WITH GINGER BACON BUTTER

INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 lb salted butter (softened)
- 1/2 cup bacon fat
- 1/3 cup grated ginger (use a microplane)
- 3 garlic cloves (grated on the microplane)
- zest of 3 limes (taken off with a microplane)
- juice of 3 limes
- 1/2 cup chopped cilantro
- Fresh corn (in the husk)

DIRECTIONS

1. For the Butter: Combine all seven ingredients in a mixer fitted with the paddle attachment. Mix until it is evenly blended. Using a spatula, turn the butter onto wax or parchment paper and mold it into a log. Chill.



2. For the Corn: Shuck the corn removing all of the husk and silk. Preheat. a grill (charcoal creates better flavor). Brush the corn on all sides with olive oil. Using tongs grill the corn on all sides until golden in some spots. The corn may pop so be careful. Once it looks delicious, transfer the corn to a platter, season it with a little salt and rub it all over with the ginger bacon butter.




