SUPPLEMENTAL RECRUITMENT INITIATIVES

The employment unit engaged in the following broad outreach initiatives in accordance with various elements of FCC Rule 73.2080(c)(2):

Participation in at least four (4) job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions.

The stations participated in the following job fairs during the reporting period: 1) Newmark Graduate School of Journalism at CUNY Career Fair (October, 2025); 2) Fairfield University Spring Career and Internship Fair (February, 2025); 3) NAHJ (National Association of Hispanic Journalists) Conference and Career Fair (July, 2025); 4) University of Connecticut/Hartford Career Fair (January, 2025); 5) Newington High School Career Fair (April, 2025).

Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment.

The stations have a robust internship program designed to train students and members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment. Fifteen (15) students participated in internships in radio talk show production, social media, news, and community engagement. The stations were the recipient of grants from individuals and university funders who funded the majority of the internships.

Participation in job banks, Internet programs, and other programs designed to promote outreach generally.

The stations routinely participate in job banks, including the *Corporation for Public Broadcasting (CPB) Jobline* and Current's publicmediajobs.org and promote general recruiting through journalism conferences and university/college and high school career fairs. In addition, the stations subscribe to an internet-based virtual platform to promote outreach and recruitment called "Handshake".

Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher-level positions.

During the reporting period, the stations continued their training and development program with LinkedIn, called “LinkedIn Learning”, where twenty (20) employees have participated in a variety of training topics. In addition, seventeen (17) supervisory employees participated in a management training program called “Everyday Leaders” offered by Leadership Greater Hartford. Lastly, other available training is available through our human resources and payroll provider, ADP, where sixteen (16) courses were completed.

Participation in at least four events or programs sponsored by educational institutions relating to career opportunities in broadcasting.

During the reporting period, the stations participated in the following programs sponsored by education institutions: 1) DART Center for Journalism at the Columbia Journalism School on the topic of “Stress, Trauma, and Burn-Out” (January, 2025); 2) Farmington Valley Transition Academy tour of station newsroom and presentations by reporters (February, 2025); 3) Fairfield University School of Journalism class presentations on news writing and public relations (February, 2025); 4) East Hartford High School Adult Education career conversation on the topic of “Jobs in Media and Broadcasting” (April, 2025).
