

## Essential Question

What is it like to work as a software developer?

## Vocabulary

- **Algorithm**– A set of step-by-step instructions used to solve a problem or perform a task.
- **Code**– The written instructions used in programming language that tells a computer what to do.
- **Software Developer Life Cycle**– The process developers follow to plan, design, build, test and maintain software.

## Before Viewing

Have students jot down answers to the following questions:

- What does it mean to be a software developer?
- What are the job duties of a software developer?
- What is the typical work environment of a software developer?
- What tools are used by a software developer to do his/her daily tasks?
- What is the education required to be a software developer?
- What are the skills necessary for being a software developer?
