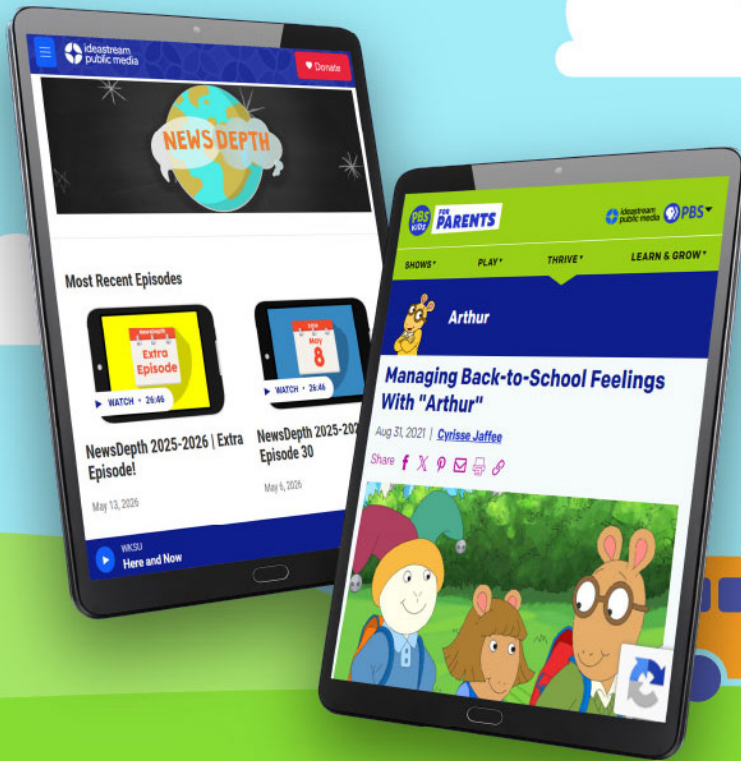

## DOMINICK FARINACCI REMEMBERS 9/11

September 11, 2001 was the inaugural first day of classes for the Juilliard School jazz program. That morning, however, nothing went according to plan for the incoming jazz students, including trumpeter and Cleveland native Dominick Farinacci [pictured]. In an interview earlier this year, he recalled, “I remember looking out the window and seeing the smoke.” The Juilliard campus went into lockdown, the residence hall was temporarily evacuated, and the academic schedule was suspended for the rest of the week. In lieu of attending classes, the students presented informal public performances as a way to cope with their own shock and find meaningful connection with others, demonstrating the healing power of jazz in times of tragedy.

The impact of 9/11 has stayed with Dominick all these years, evidenced by his recent project, *Behind the Lines: A 9/11 Story* – a musical event that focuses on remembering those lost in the 2001 terror attacks as well as honoring first responders and military veterans.

“Over the course of my career, I’ve been really passionate about using music as a way to integrate important messages and important stories in our culture,” says Dominick. “We all have gone through [trauma] in our personal lives, and that has impacted our mental wellbeing.”

*Behind the Lines: A 9/11 Story* will be presented at the Connor Palace September 9.

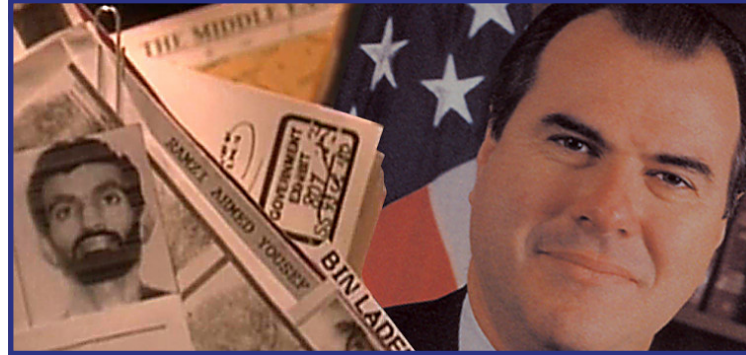
