**B. PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

On November 1, 2025, at about 2121 hours, Buckeye Police Officer Carri Carrico #5872 arrested V001 for reckless driving. V001 was transported to the Buckeye Police Department located at 100 N. Apache Road, Buckeye, Arizona for booking. V001 was handcuffed with her hands behind her back prior to being placed into the rear compartment of the patrol vehicle and remained handcuffed after arriving at the police station.

Video recordings from Officer Carrico's Axon body worn camera and the interior surveillance camera show that during efforts to restrain V001 to the bench, Officer Carrico shoved V001 forward. V001 reacted by grabbing Officer Carrico's hand while still handcuffed behind her back. Officer Carrico pulled out her right hand and punched V001 on the right side of the face with her right hand. V001 was handcuffed behind her back when she was struck. Officer Carrico then secured V001 to the bench without further incident.

During the interview with V001, she stated she felt a "jab" on her face and saw "black and spots" lasting between ten to twenty seconds.

Based on the victim interview and review of all video evidence, there was no indication that V001 attempted to assault Officer Carrico or placed her in imminent danger. V001 was 37 weeks pregnant and physically restrained at the time she was punched. V001 was transported to Abrazo West Hospital due to head pain [REDACTED]

**B. PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT**

On January 25, 2026, at approximately 1940 hours, Buckeye Police Officers Carri Carrico #5872 and Officer in Training Connor #6425 transported V001 to the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) Intake, Transfer, and Release (ITR) facility at 2670 S. 28th Drive, Phoenix. Prior to transport, V001 was handcuffed with hands behind his back and remained handcuffed until placed in an isolation cell at ITR.

ITR surveillance video captured V001 exiting the transport vehicle in the sallyport. As V001 stepped out, he lunged forward and headbutted Officer Carrico. Officer Carrico reacted by taking V001 to the ground and he was then taken inside ITR.

MCSO Detention staff directed officers to relocate V001 to the padded wall further inside the pre search area. During this escort, surveillance video captured Officer Carrico delivering a closed fist strike to the right side of V001's head. At the time of this strike, V001 remained handcuffed and was being physically controlled by both officers. Video does not depict V001 actively resisting, attempting to assault the officers, or making sudden movements during the escort.

Multiple MCSO Detention staff witnessed Officer Carrico strike V001 while he was restrained and redness was observed on the right side of V001's face.

Officer Carrico provided a written statement authored by her where she acknowledged delivering a "distraction strike."

Based on video evidence, witness statements, and interviews, probable cause exists that Officer Carrico committed aggravated assault by striking V001

while he was physically restrained and not posing an imminent threat. The following charge is submitted for review:

A.R.S. 13-1204.A4 - Aggravated Assault (Class 6 Felony) a person commits aggravated assault if the person commits assault as prescribed by section 13-1203 while the victim is bound or otherwise physically restrained. Officer Carrio punched V001 in the face while he was handcuffed, the officers appeared to have control of V001 when the unprovoked strike was delivered, V001 was looking away from officers.
