About KISU-FM

KISU-FM is a non-commercial public radio station located on the Pocatello campus of Idaho State University in the Pond Student Union Building. The station is home to all ISU Football, Women's Basketball, and Men's Basketball radio broadcasts. The Audio Board Operator / Athletics Broadcast Engineer plays a key role in delivering these live broadcasts to listeners.

Key Responsibilities

- Arrive one hour prior to each broadcast to verify remote connections with athletics announcers.
- Arrange music and sponsorship messages prior to each event; periodically record announcements and perform light on-air voice work.
- Operate the studio mixer/audio console at KISU during all ISU Football and Basketball radio broadcasts.

Required Qualifications

- No prior radio experience is necessary; training will be provided.
- Must be available when athletics events occur. This generally requires flexibility on Thursday evenings and Saturdays.
- Must be able to cover at least 90% of scheduled games.

- Able to work independently.
- Functions well in a fast-paced environment with occasional distractions.

- Interest in learning broadcast and audio software tools, including: Adobe Audition, RCS Zetta Radio Automation, and OMT Media Touch.
